Niver Canal Trail Colorado



The Niver Canal Trail parallels the Coronado Parkway for nearly 2 miles across Thornton, a northern suburb of Denver. About mid-



The Niver Canal Trail parallels the Coronado Parkway for nearly 2 miles across Thornton, a northern suburb of Denver. About mid-way, the trail passes Rotella Park, which offers restrooms, picnic shelters, a playground, and volleyball and basketball courts.

At its eastern end, the trail connects to the <u>Platte River Trail</u>, a 28-mile north-south route along the waterway.

From the trail's western terminus, you can easily continue your journey on the <u>Niver Creek Trail</u>. Make the connection on the west side of Grant Street, only a few blocks away. The trail travels 2 miles northwest, connecting two parks and the Niver Creek Open Space.
