Janesville's Spring Brook Trail provides an important non-motorized route to many of the city's popular recreational amenities. The pathway begins just off the eastern terminus of the [Rock River Parkway Trail](#) and crosses the river on its journey through the city's northeastern neighborhoods.

Along the way, the trail provides access to Jeffris Park, Lions Park (and the Rotary Botanical Gardens), Blackhawk Meadows Park and Palmer Park.

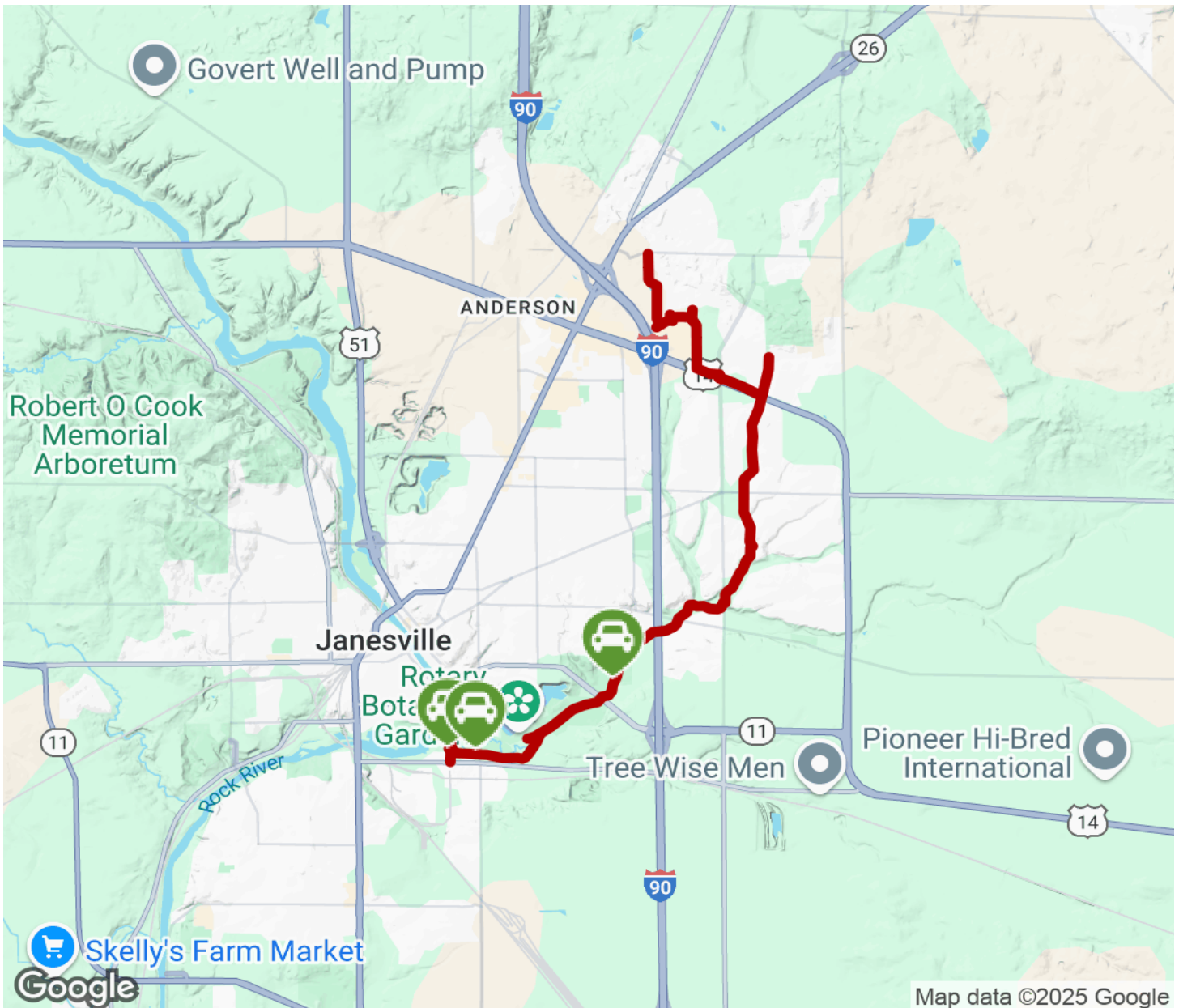
Parking & Trail Access
