Ohlone Loop Trail

California

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The Ohlone Loop Trail offers a birder's paradise in a wetland area of Watsonville on California's central coast. Its location, bordering a residential area, provides easy access for residents to experience the natural habitats of the Struve Slough. Along the 3-mile paved pathway, you might see owls, falcons, hawks, ducks and other waterfowl or raptors.

At the northern end of the trail, cross Main Street to pick up the [Upper Struve Slough Trail](#) for further exploring of the scenic waterway. Or, explore a neighboring marsh along the [Watsonville Slough Trail](#).

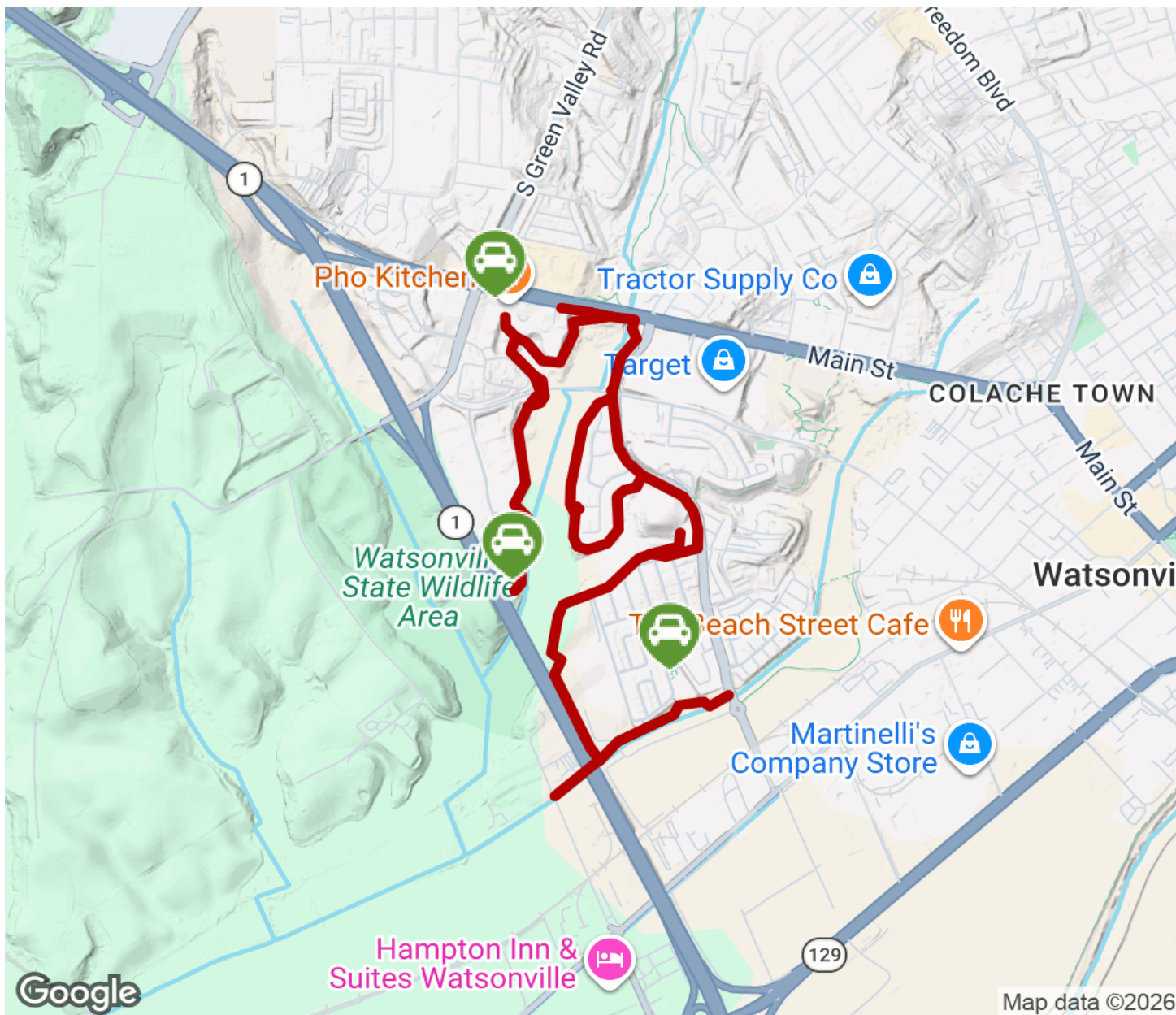
Parking & Trail Access
