

About the Route

Well-spaced shelters along the trail offer pleasant places to rest in the shade; many are even furnished with ice water. The park, a short distance northwest of Tampa, is one of the largest natural areas in Pasco County. A mixture of pine woods, wetlands, and palmetto scrub can be experienced here, and recreational opportunities include hiking, biking, birding, horseback riding, and camping.

For further adventuring, trail users can continue on the 42mile <u>Suncoast Trail</u> from the northeastern terminus.

At the southern terminus, a connection to the <u>Starkey Gap</u> <u>Trail</u> is available.

The Starkey Wilderness Paved Path runs between the Suncoast Trail (Land O'Lakes) and Starkey Gap Trail (Trinity).


