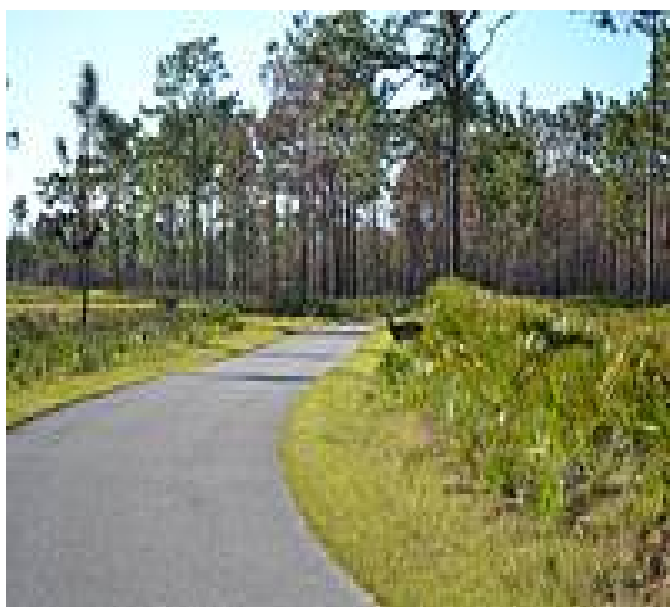

The paved trail in Jay B. Starkey Wilderness Park stretches across the preserve for about 6 miles. About the Route Well-spaced



For further adventuring, trail users can continue on the 42-mile [Suncoast Trail](#) from the northeastern terminus.

At the southern terminus, a connection to the [Starkey Gap Trail](#) is available.

The paved trail in Jay B. Starkey Wilderness Park stretches across the preserve for about 6 miles.

About the Route

Well-spaced shelters along the trail offer pleasant places to rest in the shade; many are even furnished with ice water. The park, a short distance northwest of Tampa, is one of the largest natural areas in Pasco County. A mixture of pine woods, wetlands, and palmetto scrub can be experienced here, and recreational opportunities include hiking, biking, birding, horseback riding, and camping.

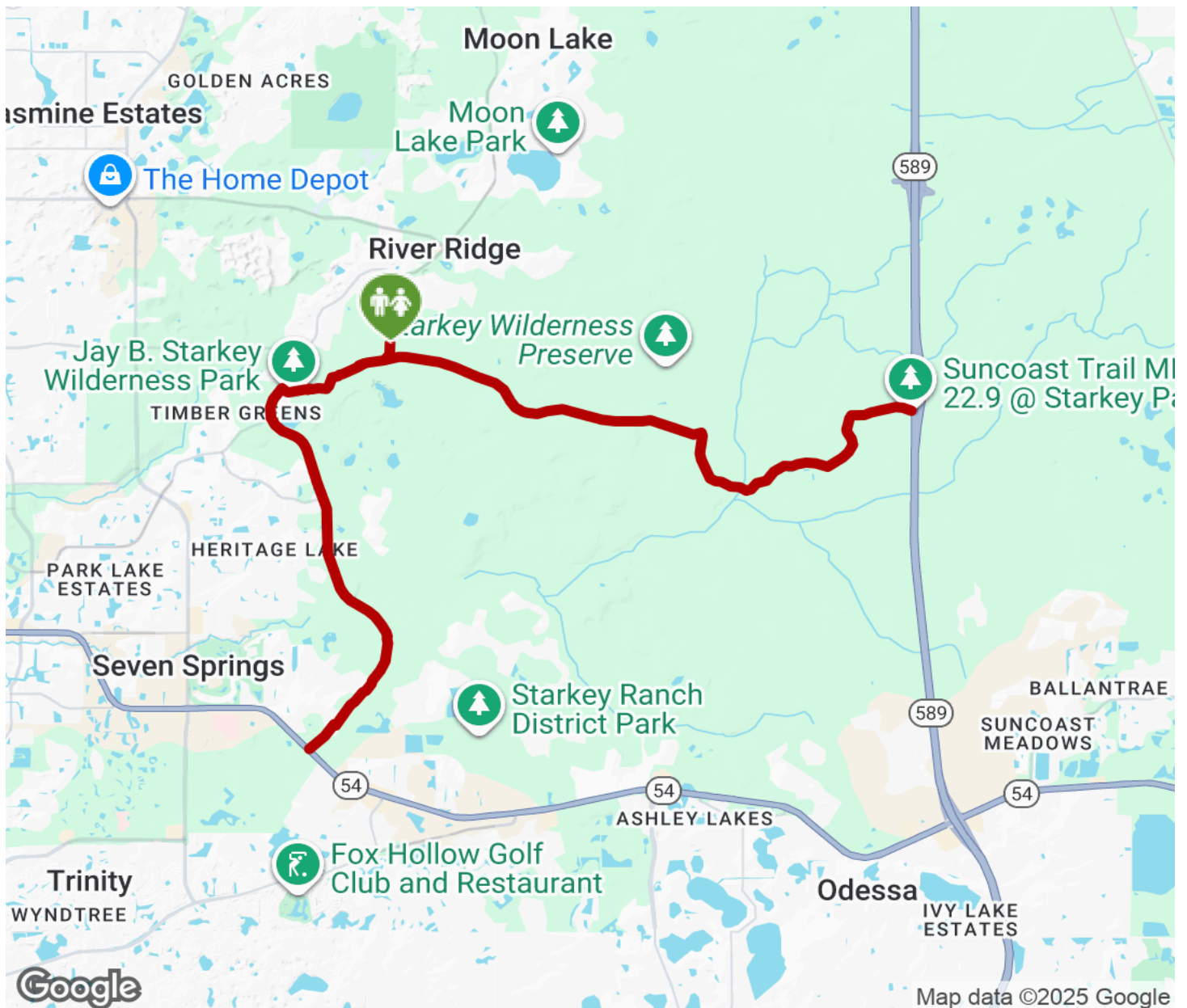
