The I-84 Bike Path leaves in the east from the I-84 intersection with Fairview Parkway and continues west along the interstate for nearly 5 miles. A fence and concrete barrier separate trail-goers from traffic. Although not scenic, the bike path offers an important commuter route connecting commercial and residential areas in northeast Portland and Gresham.
