Although less than 2 miles long, the Hagan-Burke Trail provides valuable connections to three other trails in the city of Carmel: the Monon Trail (an 18-mile RTC Hall-of-Famer that stretches to Indianapolis), the 146th Street Trail that travels east-west through town, and the Greyhound Trail. The paved trail, named after two community leaders, Judy Hagan and Ed Burke, winds through wooded areas along Cool Creek.
