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The University of Maine Bicycle Path is a valuable link for non-motorized transportation, connecting campus with Old Town. Much of the trail passes through a scenic wooded corridor, following the path of a long-disused railway. The trail offers access to the university's system of cross-country ski trails, which are popular with joggers and walkers in summer.

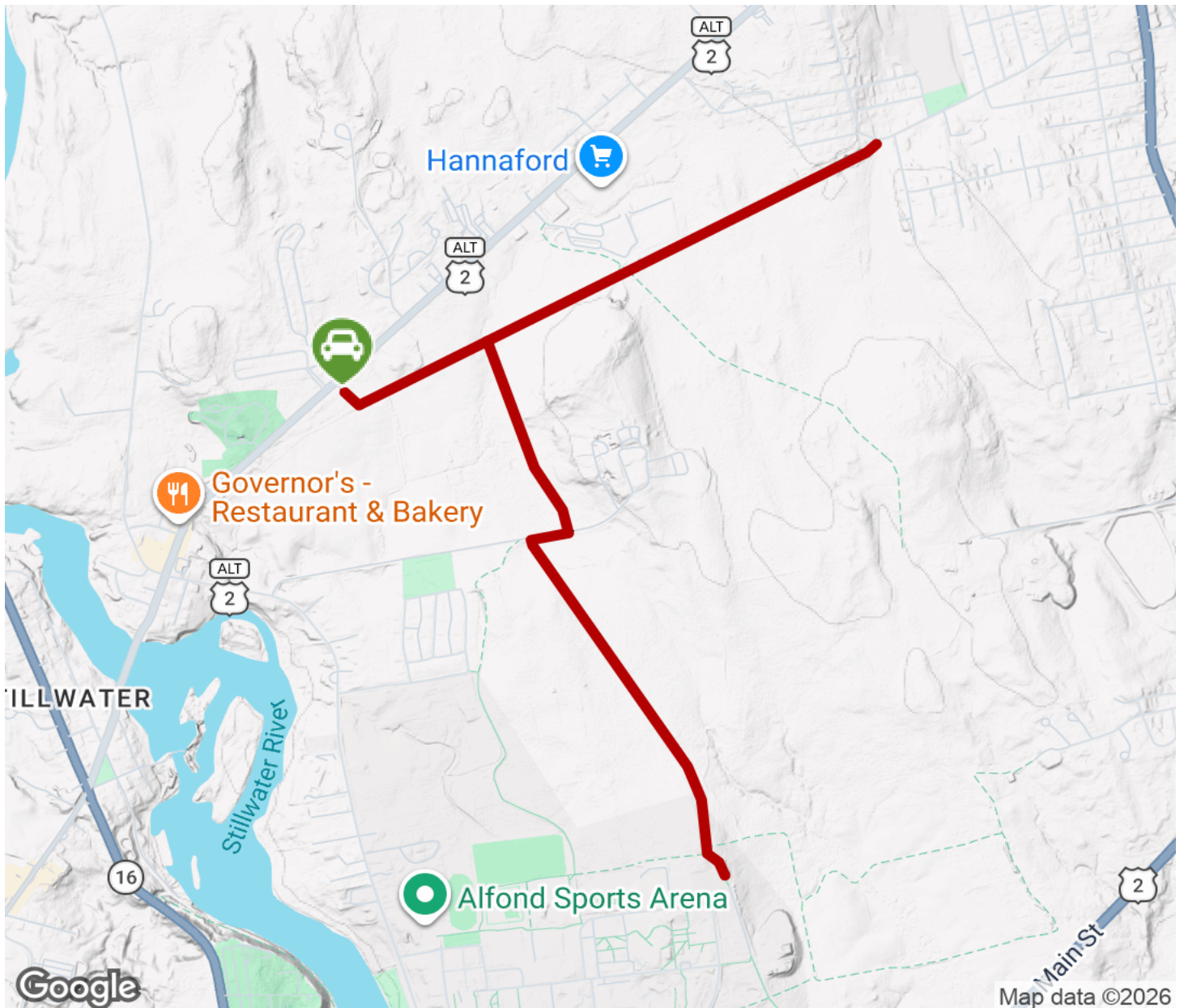
