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The Newport News Park Bikeway offers a pleasant 5-mile loop through southern Virginia woodlands. The unpaved trail takes you through the 8,000-acre park and offers a connection to Colonial National Historical Park, where you can visit George Washington's headquarters at the Yorktown Battlefield. Other recreational activities in the park include: archery, golf, fishing, hiking and mountain biking.

Bikes can be rented at the park's campsite office. Note that young children are required to wear a helmet on the trail.
