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Although short, the Lindale Trail provides an important off-road east-west connection between Cedar Rapids and Marion. The tree-lined route, along the former Canadian National Railway, is nestled between houses and businesses. At its eastern end, it connects to the [Boyson Trail](#), a recreational corridor linking several parks. At its western end sits the Rockwell Collins complex, the area's largest private employer, making the route a valuable one for commuters.

It is one day planned to extend the trail west to the [Cedar River Trail](#) and east to the [Grant Wood Trail](#).

Parking & Trail Access


A parking lot is available at the western end of the trail, off C. Avenue Northeast in Cedar Rapids.
