Parking is available in Baumann Park (300 S. Walnut Street).



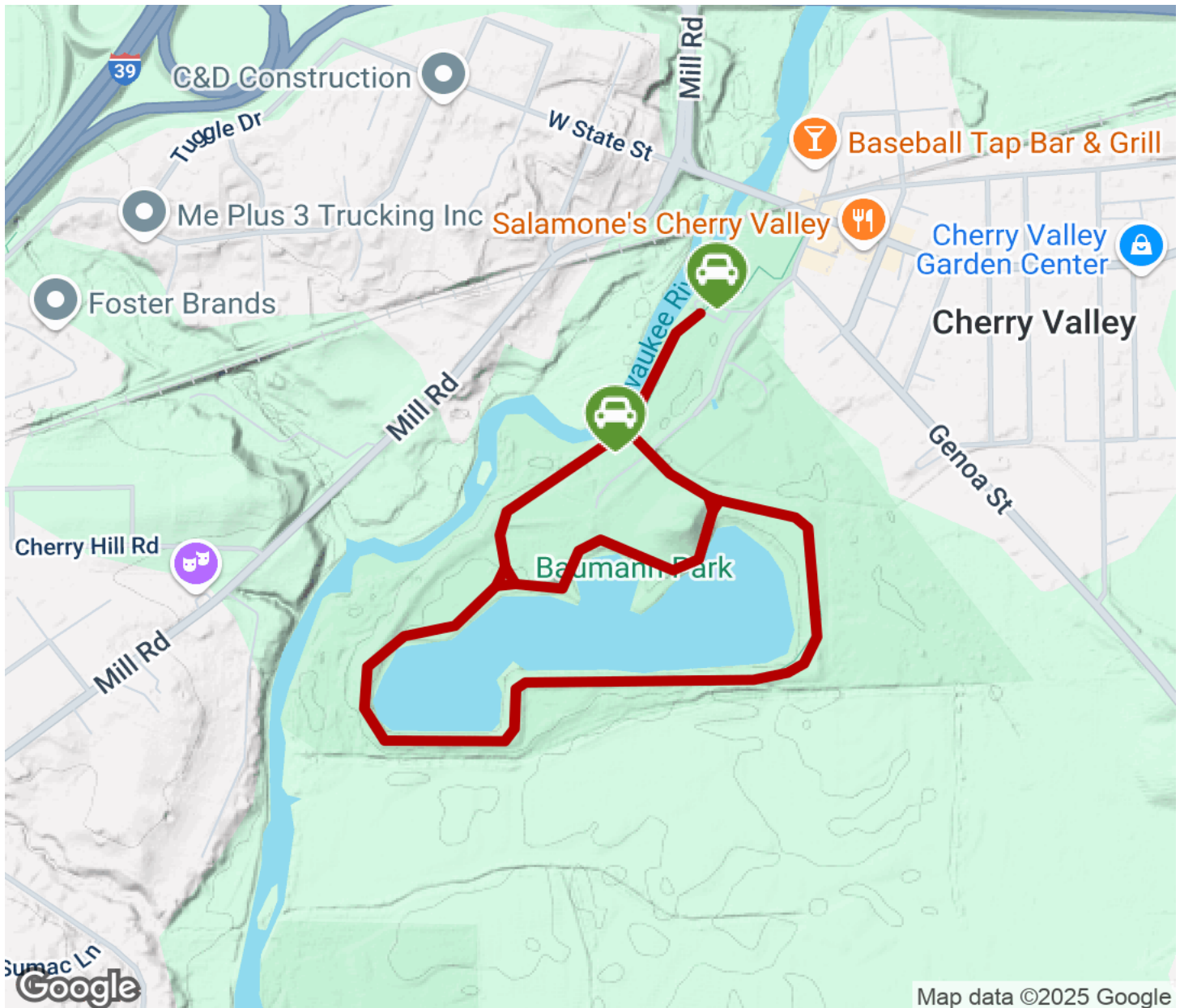
