Baumann Park is adjacent to the Kishwaukee River in Cherry Valley, a community on the outskirts of Rockford in northern Illinois. A paved pathway runs through the park and loops around Baumann Park Lake. The park offers a playground, baseball fields, tennis and basketball courts, and picnic areas. Fishing is allowed in the lake.

A short distance away (via roads) you can connect to another Cherry Valley trail, the [Swanson Park Recreation Path](#), near the US 20 Bypass.

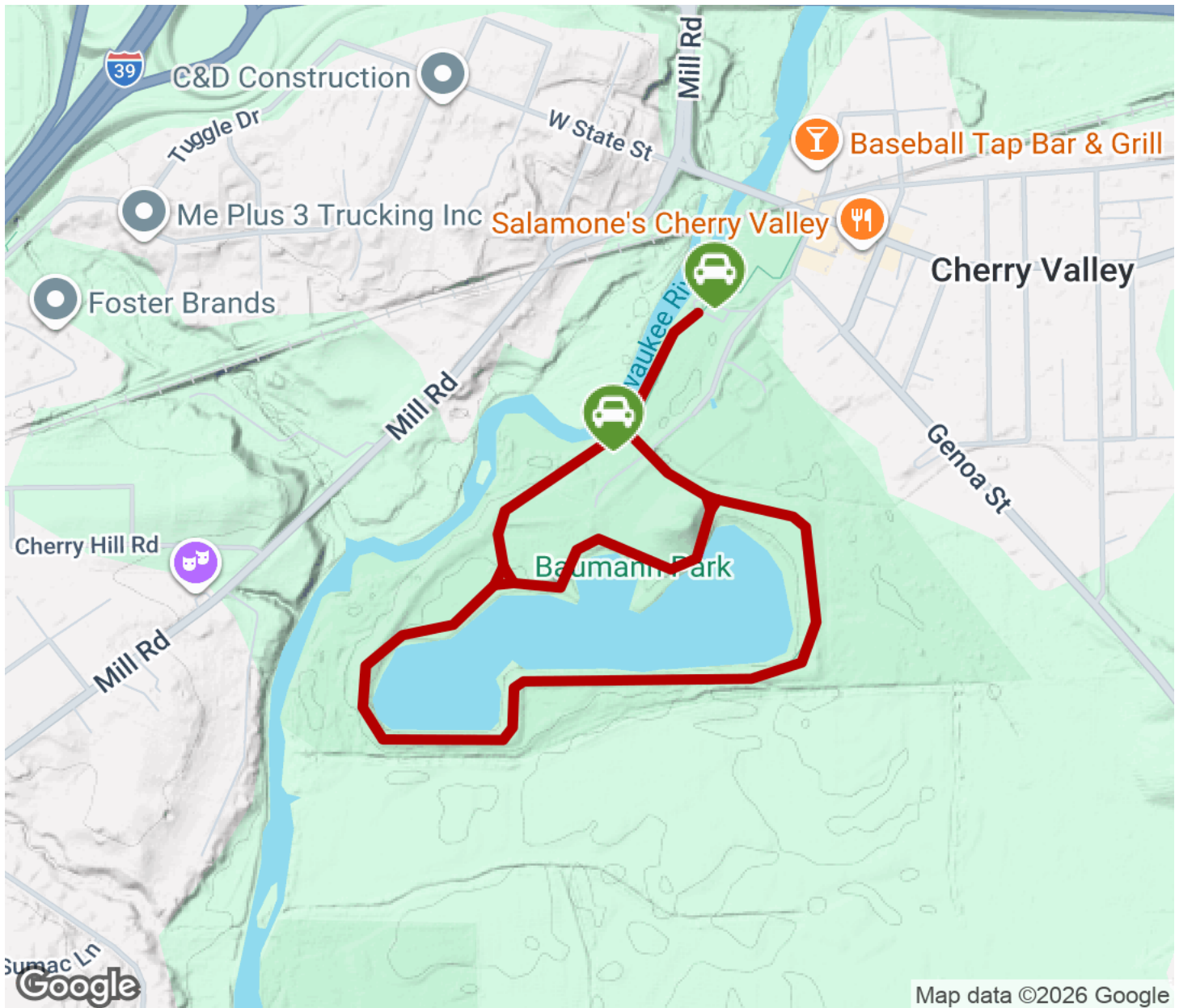
