The fine-crushed limestone trail offers a scenic trek through the pine forest surrounding the lake, where you can enjoy fishing and wildlife viewing. Along the way, you'll cross three wooden bridges over small streams.

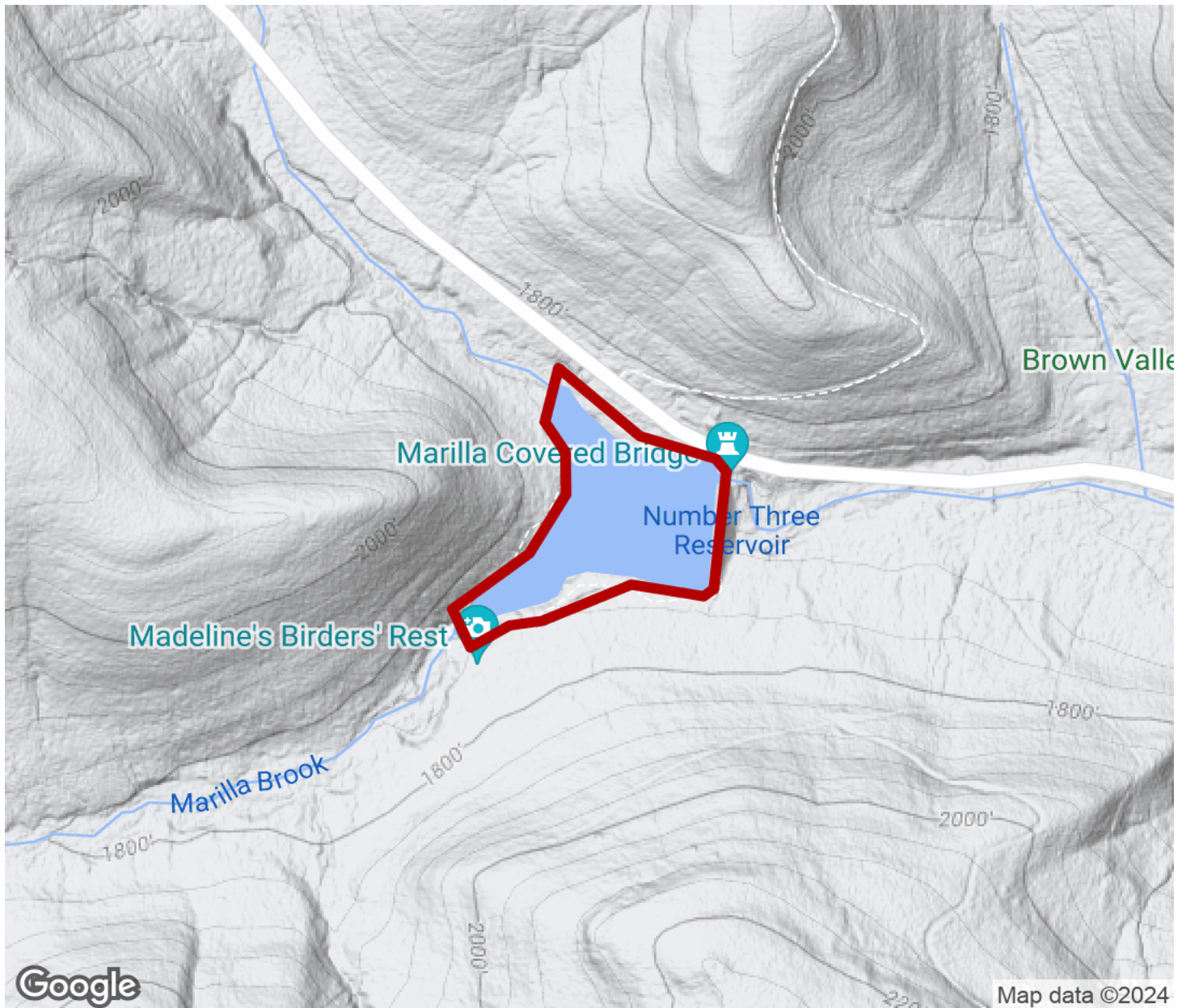
