Speight Branch Greenway

Speight Branch Greenway offers a paved, shaded route through a residential area of Cary, which lies on the western edges of Raleigh.



Speight Branch Greenway offers a paved, shaded route through a residential area of Cary, which lies on the western edges of Raleigh. The trail begins at Southeast Cary Parkway and travels north along Speight Branch Creek. A pedestrian tunnel safely takes trail-goers under Tryon Road, then the trail skirts by Macedonia Lake, where a new 24-acre park is planned. The trail ends at Tryon Village Shopping Center, which is anchored by a Harris Teeter grocery store and Walgreens drug store.

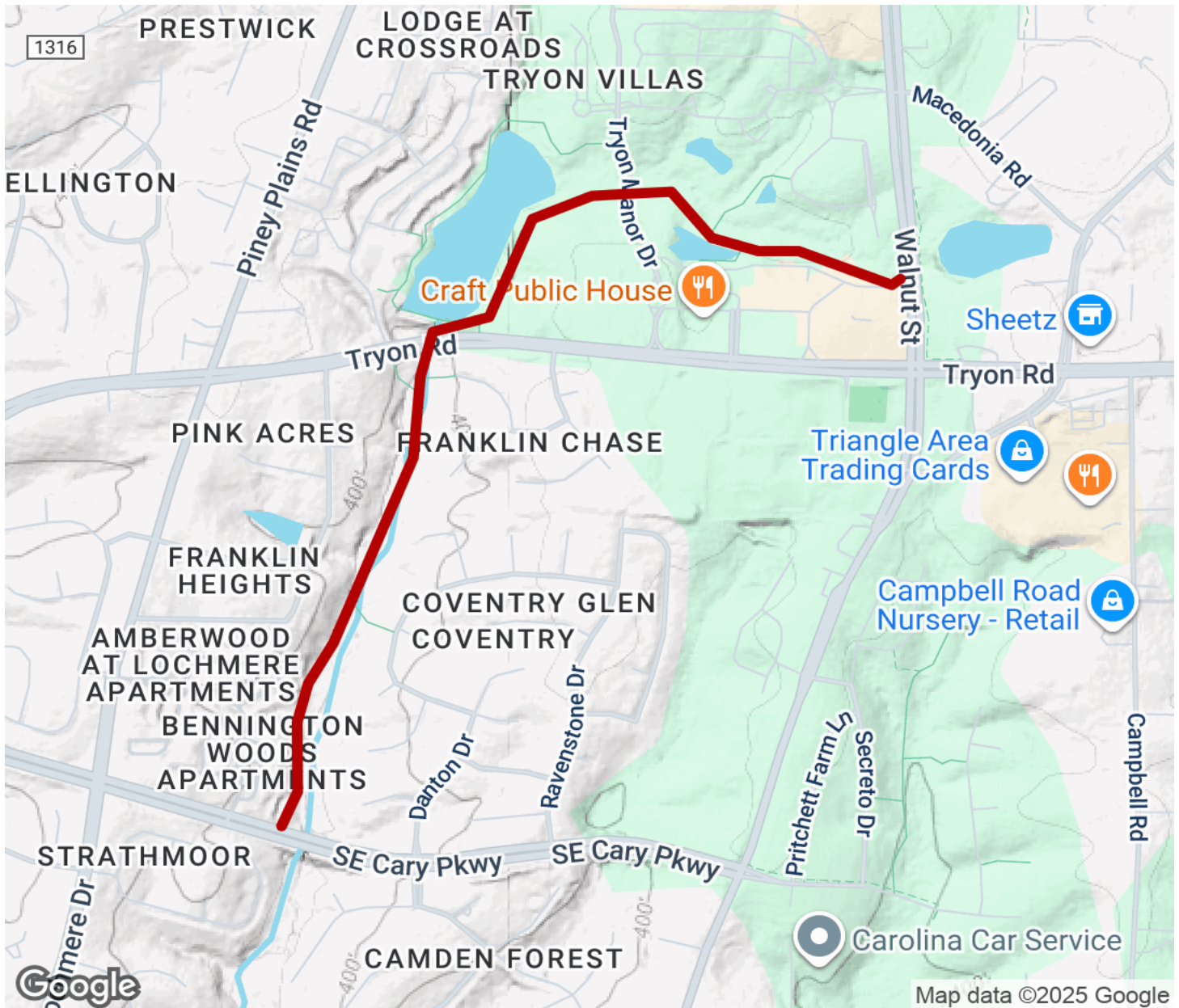
Parking & Trail Access
