The Edgewater Trail leaves from Water Street at the north end of Riverfront Park. The 23-acre park is a beautiful place to spend an afternoon and enjoy river views. It has two unique features: a carousel with dozens of hand-carved and hand-painted wooden horses, and the Eco Earth Globe, created by local artists and students.

Ride the ascending ramp and cross the Willamette River on the Center Street Bridge. On the other side, the trail follows the bank of the river between Edgewater Street and Dallas Highway.


