As one of the three multi-use trails in Longview, Texas, the Paul G. Boorman Trail (named after a long-time city employee) runs for three miles along Grace Creek. Along its route it passes the Paul G. Boorman Trail Park and Louis Jackson Park, which features a playgrounds.

Trail users can combine the Paul G. Boorman Trail, Guthrie Trail, and the Cargill Long Park Trail for an over 10-mile one trip that zigzags through the city of Longview. The Guthrie Trail leaves off from the Paul G. Boorman Trail's southern endpoint.

## Parking & Trail Access

At the Trail's northern endpoint, there is parking at 121 Summers Dr. At the southern endpoint, there is parking at 919 W Marshall Ave.

At the two parks along the trail, the Louis Jackson Park (200 Bill Owens Pkwy) and the Paul G. Boorman Trail Park (919 W Marshall Ave), there is additional parking.
