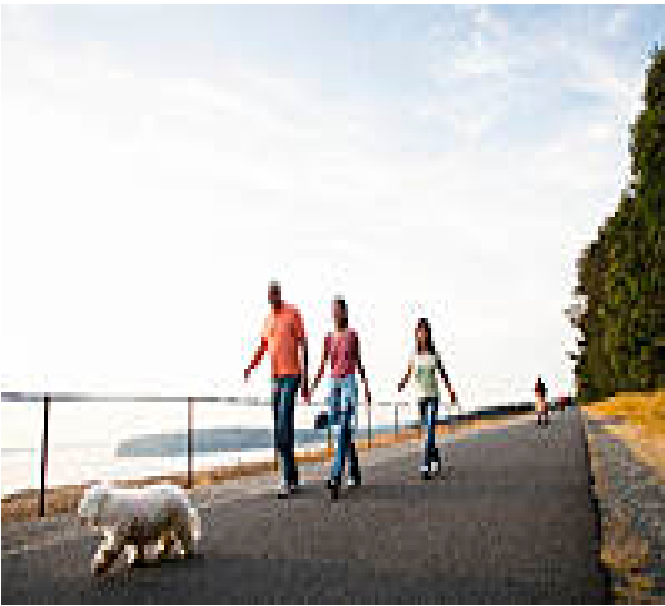

The Grandview Trail runs in a straight line for more than a mile on the eastern edge of Pierce County's Chambers Creek Regional Park.



The Grandview Trail runs in a straight line for more than a mile on the eastern edge of Pierce County's Chambers Creek Regional Park. The trail appropriately never strays too far from Grandview Drive. Living up to its name, the trail offers stunning views of the adjacent Chambers Bay public golf course (site of the U.S. Open in 2015), Puget Sound and distant islands from its position on a 200-foot bluff.

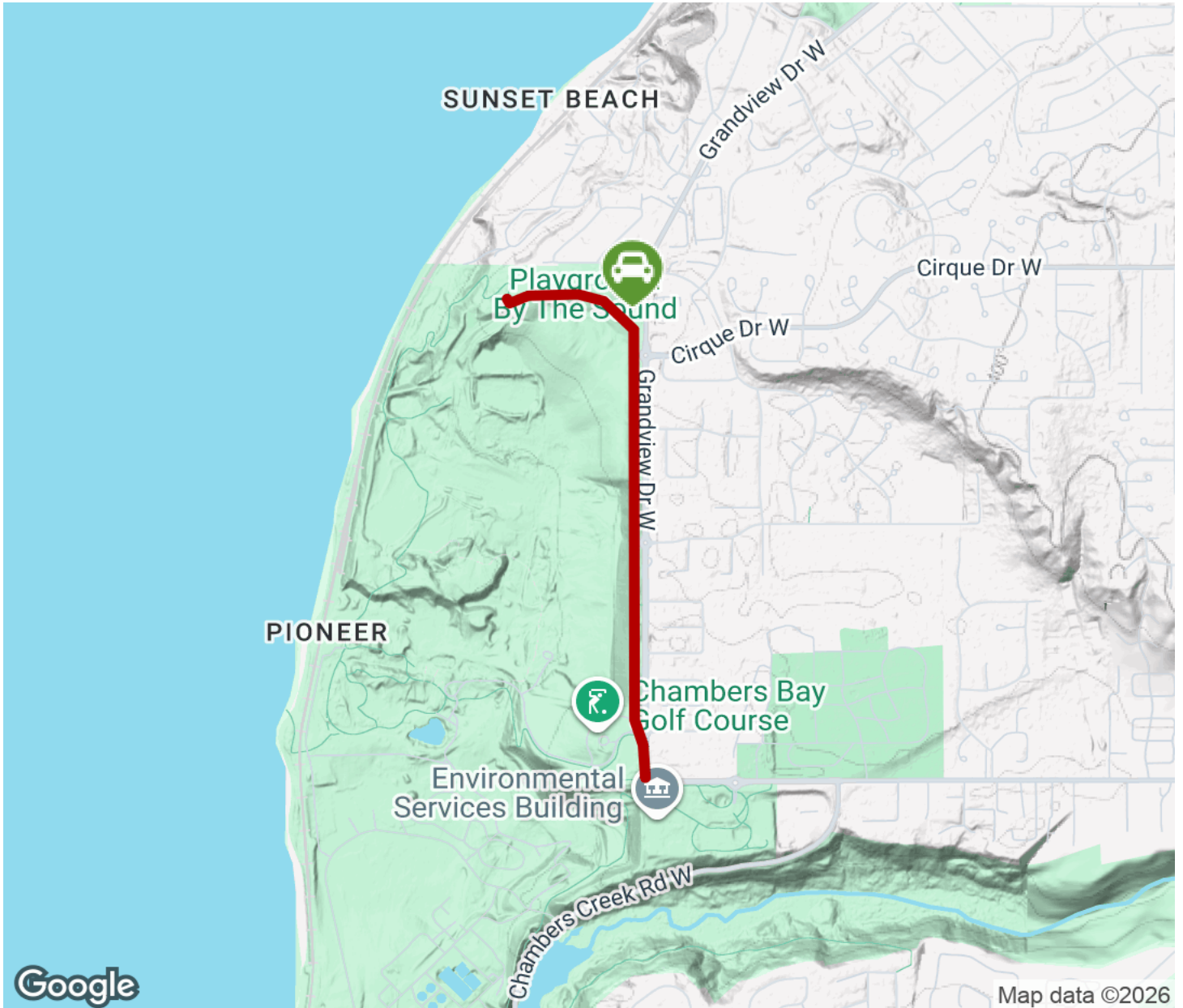
Parking & Trail Access
