Overview The Lake to Lake Bike Trail winds through the beautiful terrain of the Kettle Moraine State Forest. It is a newer, well-



Moraine. The trail passes through hardwood forests, open prairies, tall pines and lowland swamps. There is no fee to ride this trail. There are excellent swimming beaches at both Long Lake and Mauthe Lake.

Overview

The Lake to Lake Bike Trail winds through the beautiful terrain of the Kettle Moraine State Forest. It is a newer, well-maintained trail, with a wide, crushed limestone roadbed. It is used daily by hikers and bicycle enthusiasts.

About the Route

The trail connects the Long Lake and Mauthe recreation areas and passes by the village of Dundee. Dundee is small, but has a gas station/convenience store, and several places to eat and drink.

This was not a rail conversion, so the trail goes up and down as it follows the undulating topography of the Kettle

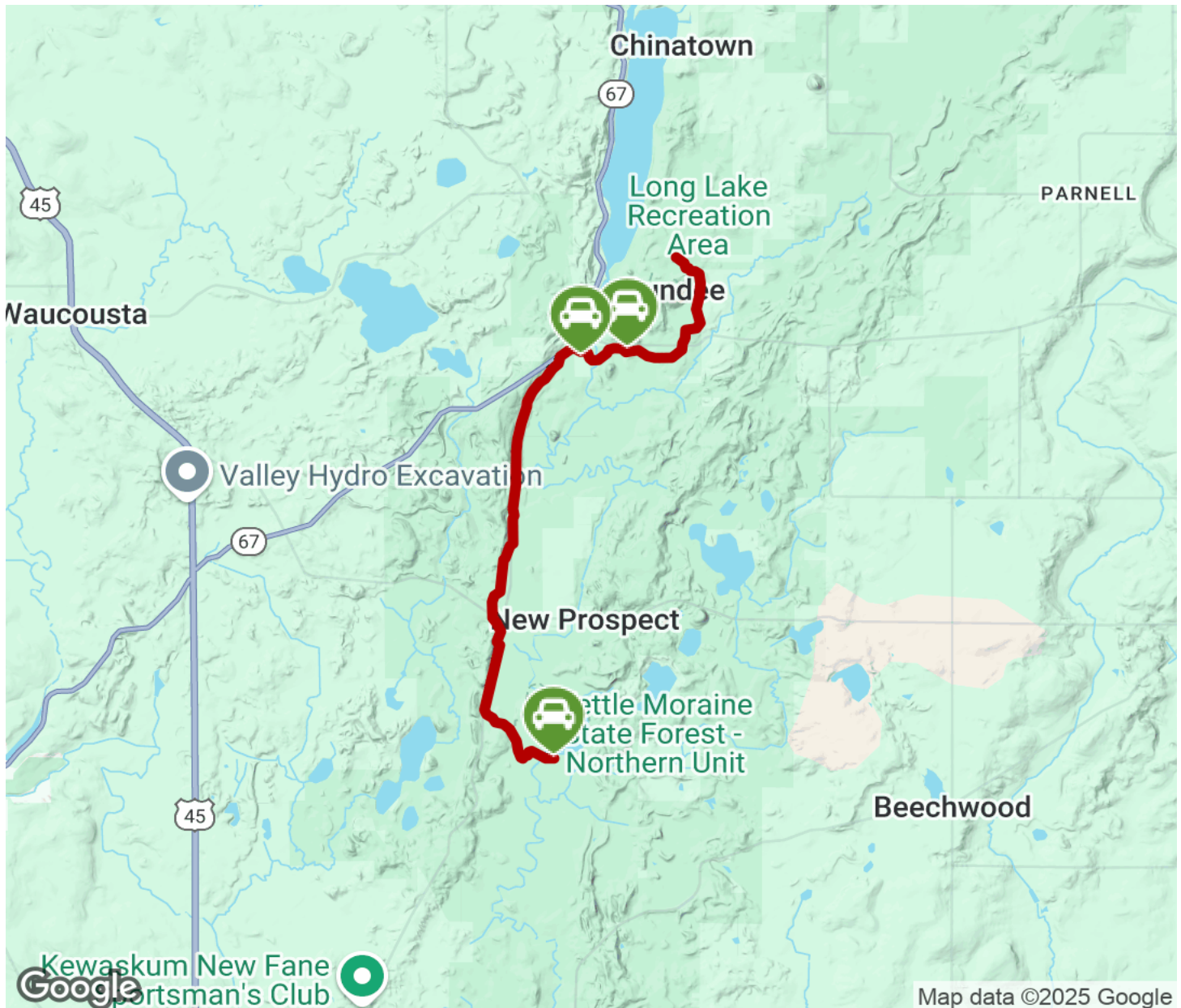
Please note that there is a small fee to enter the Long Lake Recreation Area in a vehicle.
