## A-train Rail Trail

Texas

*The A-train Rail Trail spans 19 miles, connecting the northwestern Dallas suburbs of Denton and Lewisville along an active commuter*



center, the trail also connects to the MedPark Station.

The section south of the Denton Branch includes a passage over Lewisville Lake.

Picking up from downtown Lewisville, the southernmost section of the A-train Rail Trail is also known as the Lewisville Hike and Bike Trail. This paved trail was completed in 2016 and spans 4 miles from the Old Town Station south to Hebron Station. Bordered by Lewisville Lake, the community is a recreational hub in the Dallas–Fort Worth area.

The A-train Rail Trail spans 19 miles, connecting the northwestern Dallas suburbs of Denton and Lewisville along an active commuter line operated by the Denton County Transportation Authority (DCTA). The entire trail is a rail-with-trail and follows alongside the active A-train.

### About the Route

The northern 9-mile section of the A-train Rail Trail is also known as the Denton Branch Rail Trail. It was built along the former Denton Branch of the MKT Railroad and completed in 2011. The paved pathway runs between the Downtown Denton Transit Center and Swisher Road in Lake Dallas. The route generally parallels I-35, providing access to schools, residential neighborhoods, and commercial areas. In addition to the downtown transit

The A-train Rail Trail runs between E Hickory St. (Denton) and Hebron Station, 952 Lakeside Cir. (Lewisville), with parking available on both ends.

Parking is also available at:

- MedPark Station, 3220 MedPark Dr. (Denton)
- Old Town Station, 617 E. Main St. (Lewisville)

The best way to access the A-train Rail Trail is via. the A-train itself! Bikes are allowed on the A-train; look for the bike hooks available near the ADA-accessible seats.



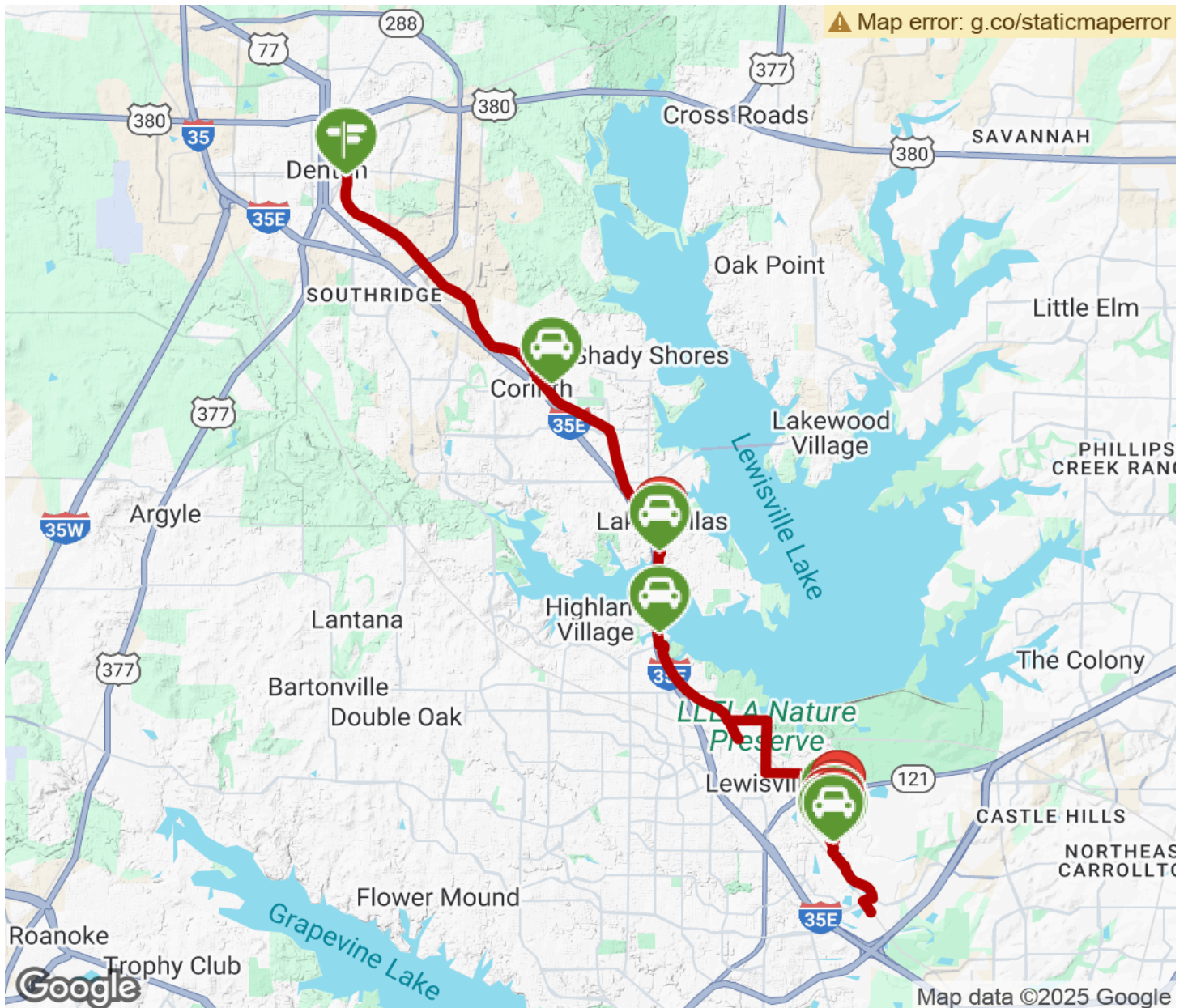
