About the Route

The Carl Henn Millennium Trail creates a circle around the city, providing a safe and convenient way to get around town or enjoy a leisurely stroll.

The trail was constructed in 2000 and was named after the excitement and promise held in the new millennium. The trail was renamed in 2011 after Rockville resident Carl Henn, a tireless advocate for sustainability and active transportation, who passed away in 2010.


