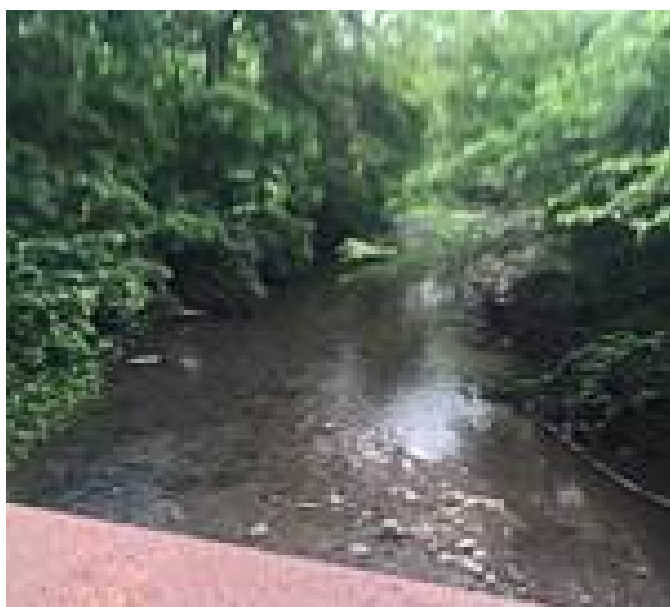

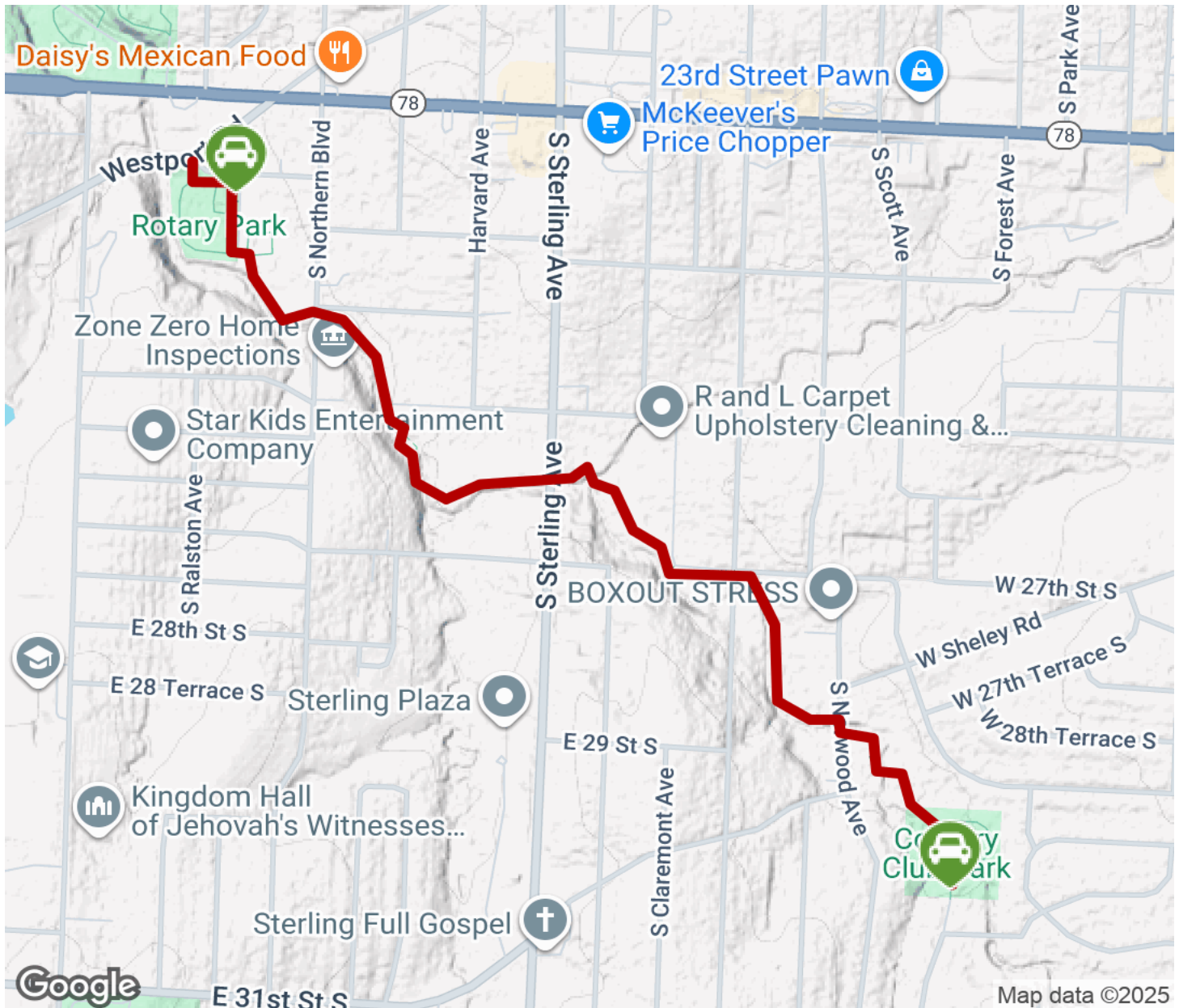
Parking & Trail Access
