Although short, this paved half-mile trail provides connections to three parks, as well as a unique attraction in northern

From there, the tree-lined route heads south to Slover Memorial Park. Cross the park traveling northeast and you'll reach the Harry S. Truman Library and Museum, where you can see photographs, film clips, and artifacts about the president's life. You can even visit an Oval Office replica.

From the park, continue south on the sidewalk paralleling North Delaware Street, which heads under US Highway 24. Shortly, you'll arrive at McCoy Park, named after the

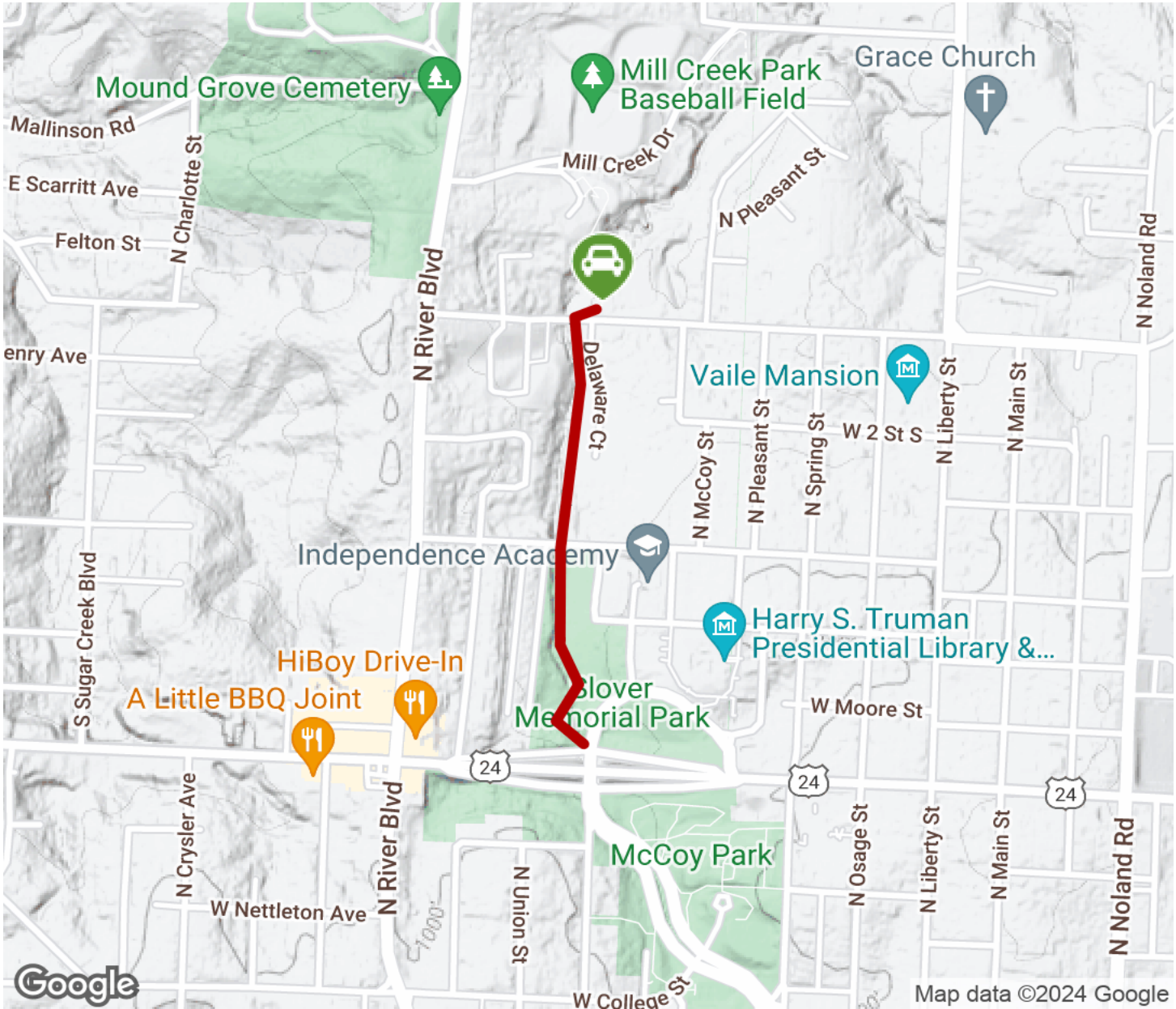
Parking & Trail Access
