# Central Oregon Canal Trail

*Central Oregon Canal Trail offers 3 miles of trail on the southern end of Bend. A good place to begin your journey is Woodriver Park*

Central Oregon Canal Trail offers 3 miles of trail on the southern end of Bend. A good place to begin your journey is Woodriver Park on the southern banks of the Deschutes River. A connection to the [Deschutes River Trail](#) can be made here to follow the waterway for 12 miles.

Head south and the trail parallels the west side Brookswood Boulevard, soon reaching Blakely Park, where there are restrooms and a popular playground. From the park, trail users stay on the west side of the boulevard to head southwest, or you can cross the roadway and follow another branch of the trail to reach the canal for which the trail was named.

The trail hugs the canal's north bank as it travels east through residential and commercial areas to end at

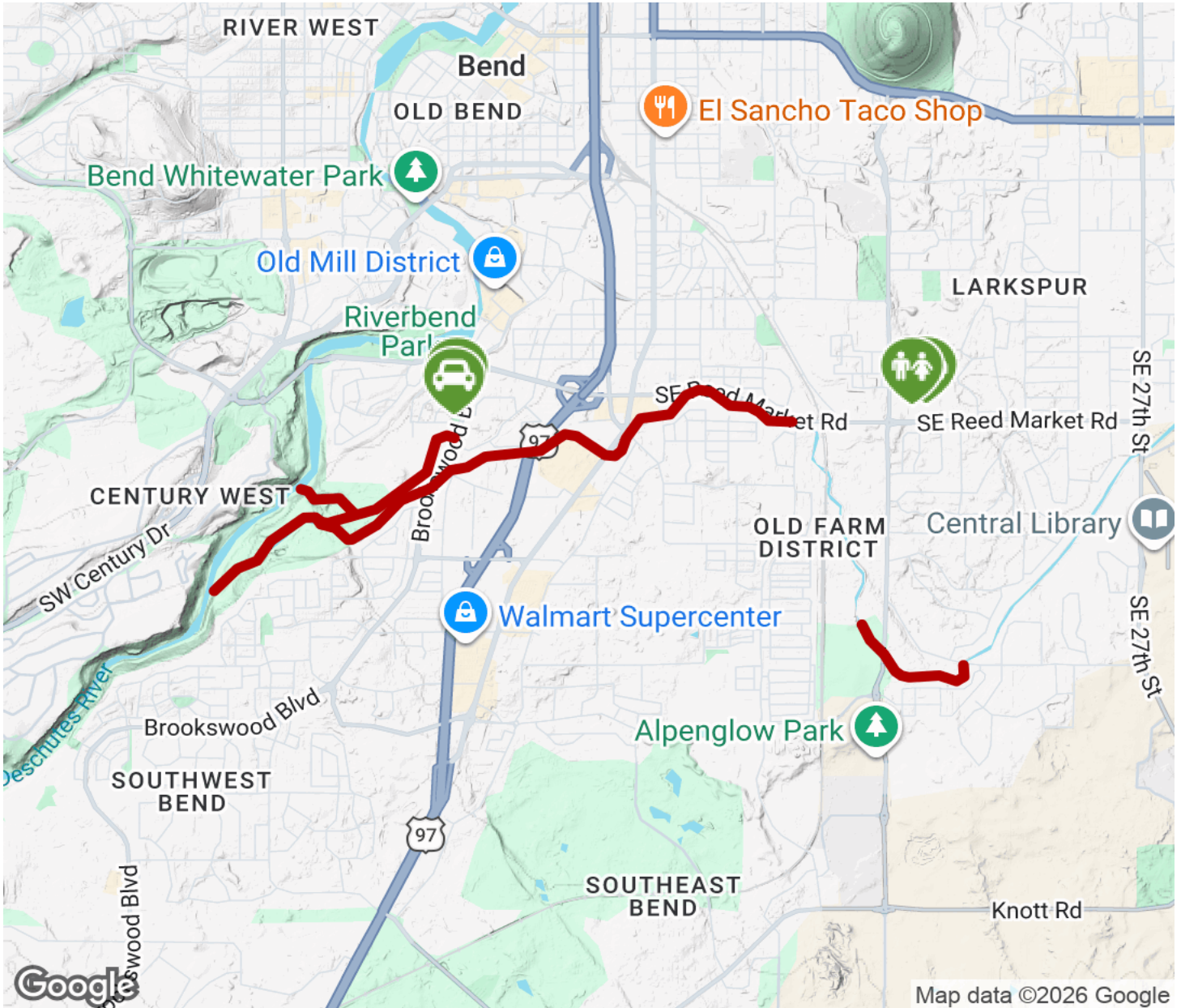
## Parking & Trail Access
