A short sidewalk connection from the trail's northern end leads to Juniper Park, which offers a swim and fitness center, playground, tennis courts, picnic areas, and restrooms.

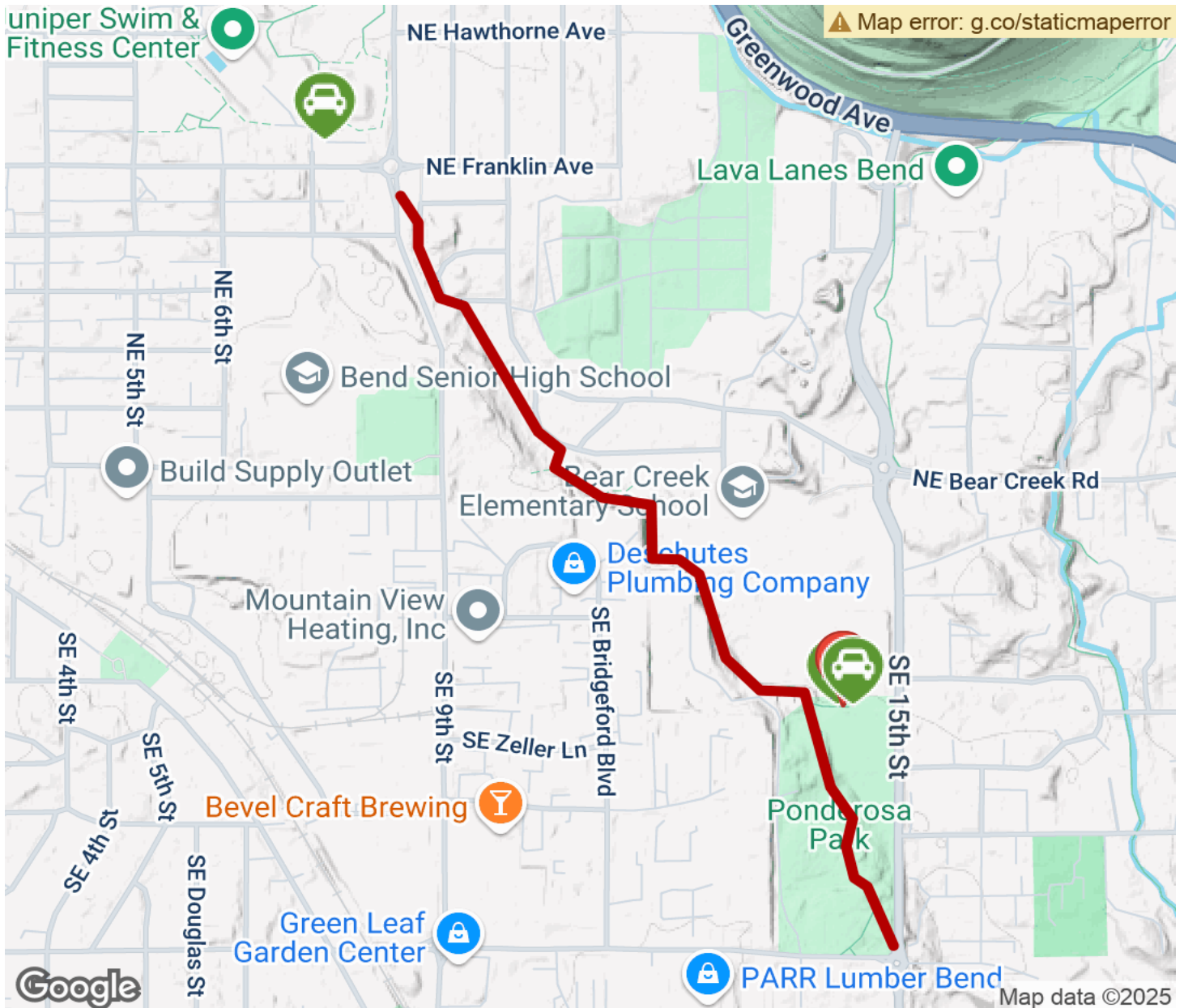
