The paved Coyner Trail runs for about a mile between two community parks, both about 20 acres. On the southern end is Ponderosa Park, where there are sports fields, a skate park, restrooms, and off-leash areas for dogs. A short sidewalk connection from the trail's northern end leads to Juniper Park, which offers a swim and fitness center, playground, tennis courts, picnic areas, and restrooms.


Parking & Trail Access
