A paved bicycle trail runs through the heart of the community from its city park to its recreation complex. Much of the trail is wooded and follows a former railroad right-of-way, which continues from the trail's eastern end as a gravel pathway that meets up with Roberts Avenue. At the trail's western end, trail users can connect to the Triple C Rail Trail.

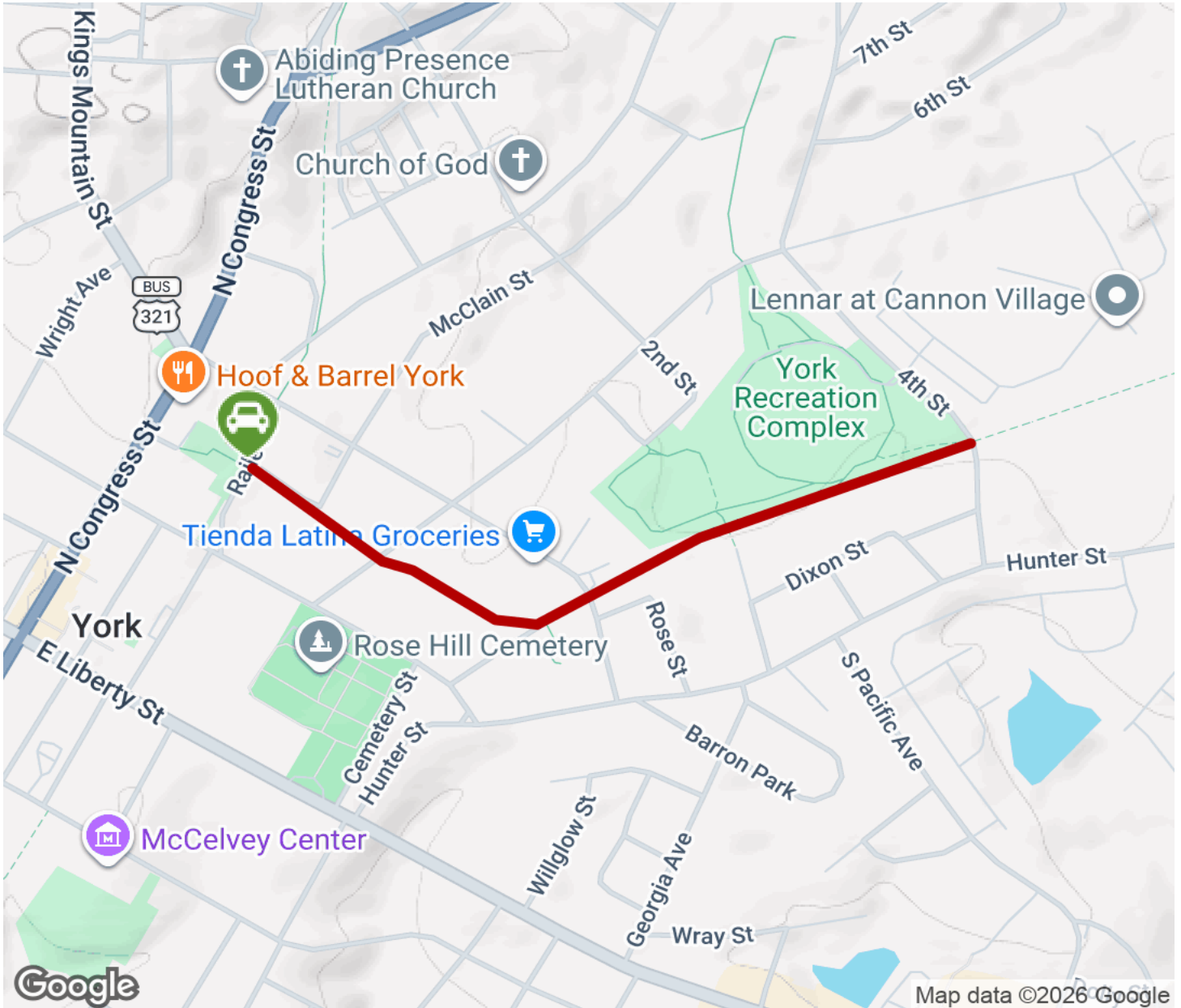
Parking & Trail Access
