Fort Morgan Road Trail begins just outside the western border of Gulf State Park and travels more than 5 miles west through the



Fort Morgan Road Trail begins just outside the western border of Gulf State Park and travels more than 5 miles west through the coastal community of Gulf Shores in southwestern Alabama. The paved trail parallels the north side of its namesake roadway (also known as Highway 180) through quiet, tree-lined neighborhoods and ends at the Peninsula Golf Club. The eastern end of the trail has a few gentle climbs, but the rest of the trail is flat.

Not far from the trail's eastern end, you can extend your adventure on one of several Hugh Branyon Backcountry Trails through Gulf State Park.

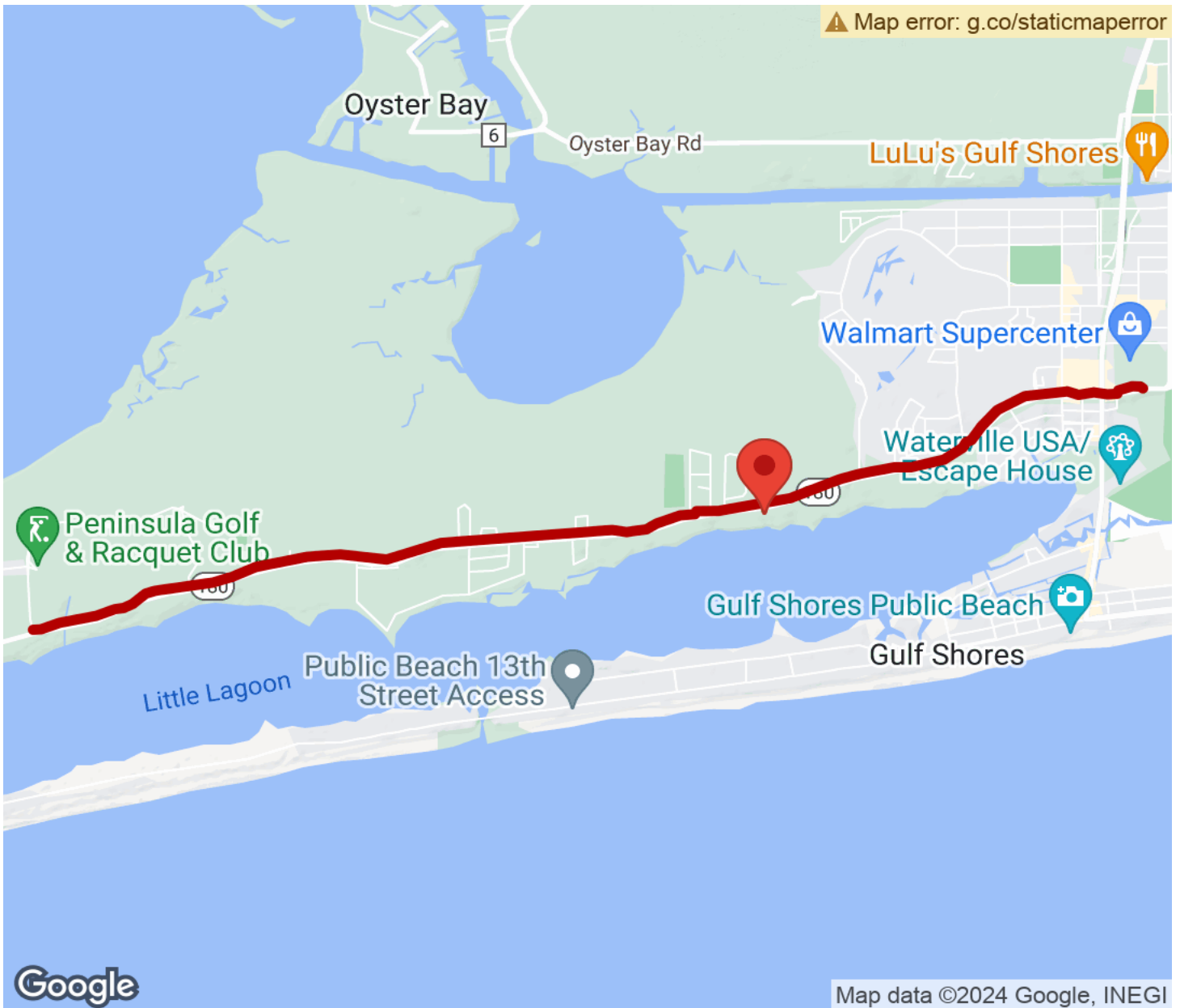
Parking & Trail Access
