






Fort Morgan Road Trail Alabama



The Fort Morgan Road Trail travels more than 5 miles west through the coastal community of Gulf Shores in southwestern



State Park.

The Fort Morgan Road Trail travels more than 5 miles west through the coastal community of Gulf Shores in southwestern Alabama.

About the Route

The paved trail parallels the north side of its namesake roadway (also known as Highway 180) through quiet, treelined neighborhoods and ends at the Peninsula Golf Club. The eastern end of the trail has a few gentle climbs, but the rest of the trail is flat.

Connections

At trail's eastern end, continue the adventure on one of several <u>Hugh Branyon Backcountry Trails</u> through Gulf
