For just over 2 miles, the Punta Gorda Harborwalk follows the beautiful Charlotte Harbor on Florida's west coast. The route is part of the city's extensive trail network and connects directly to [Linear Park](#), which follows a former railroad right-of-way.

On its western end, you can access the shops and restaurants of Fishermen's Village and, on its eastern end, lies the Charlotte Regional Medical Center. Between these two points, Gilchrist Park and Laishley Park make for pleasant stops with restrooms, picnic tables, gardens, and fishing piers.

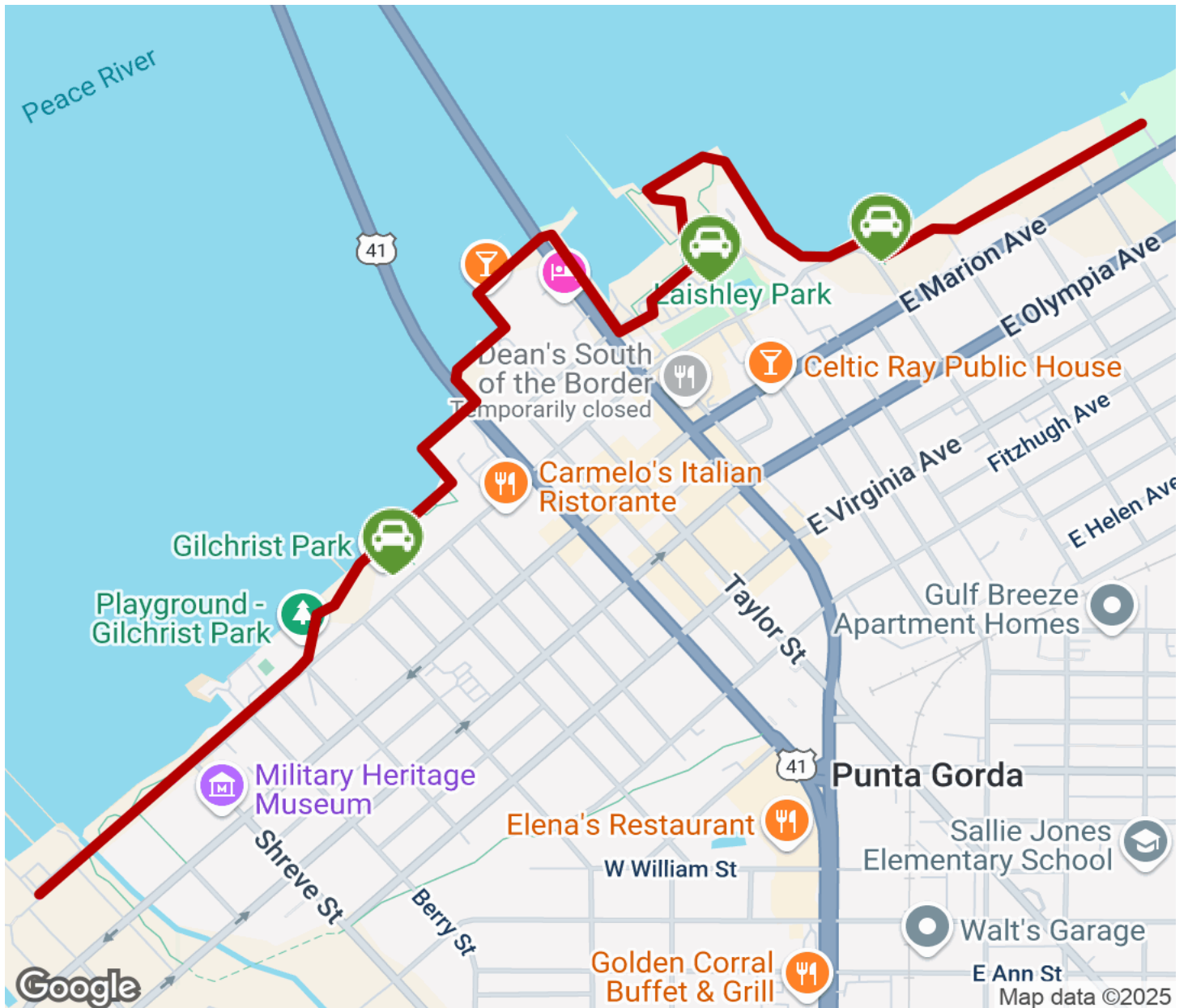
