Punta Gorda's Multi-Use Recreational Trail (MURT) begins on the south side of the city and heads northwest along US 41 (also known as Tamiami Trail). The trail stretches approximately 4 miles through the communities of Burnt Store Meadows, Burnt Store Isles, and Seminole Lakes.

From the trail's northern end on Airport Road, you can hop on the Shreve Street Connector to head toward downtown and the popular dining and shopping areas along Charlotte Harbor. On that end of the trail, two other key pieces of the city's extensive trail network can be reached: [Linear Park](#) and [Harborwalk](#), which connect parks, businesses, and residential neighborhoods.

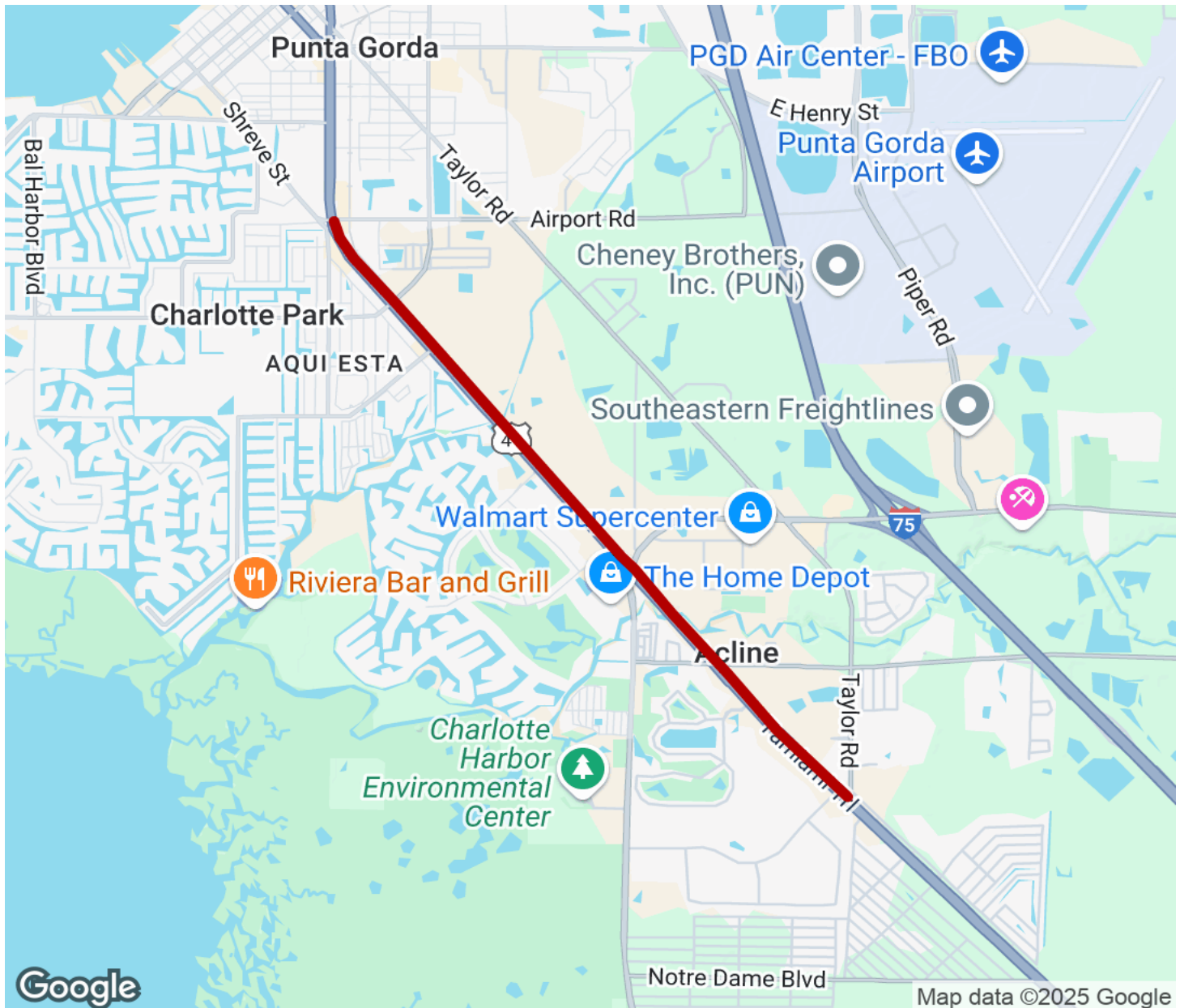
