Black Diamond Trail New York



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Connections

At the southern end of the route in Ithaca, the Black Diamond Trail connects to the Cayuga Waterfront Trail

The Back Diamond Trail stretches 8 miles of the trail are open, which follows the Lehigh Valley Railroad route whose Black Diamond Express once ran from Buffalo to New York City and gives the rail trail its name.

About the Route

The unpaved trail runs through a rural backdrop as it makes its way from Cass Park in Ithaca to Taughannock Falls State Park near Trumansburg. The southern half of the trail (about 4 miles) offers a pleasant walk from Ithaca. There are no services along this trail.

The northern end of the trail is the most scenic viewpoint, with the nearby Taughannock Falls Overlook a popular spot to visit.
