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Connections

At the southern end of the route in Ithaca, the Black Diamond Trail connects to the Cayuga Waterfront Trail

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About the Route

The unpaved trail runs through a rural backdrop as it makes its way from Cass Park in Ithaca to Taughannock Falls State Park near Trumansburg. The southern half of the trail (about 4 miles) offers a pleasant walk from Ithaca. There are no services along this trail.

The northern end of the trail is the most scenic viewpoint, with the nearby Taughannock Falls Overlook a popular spot to visit.

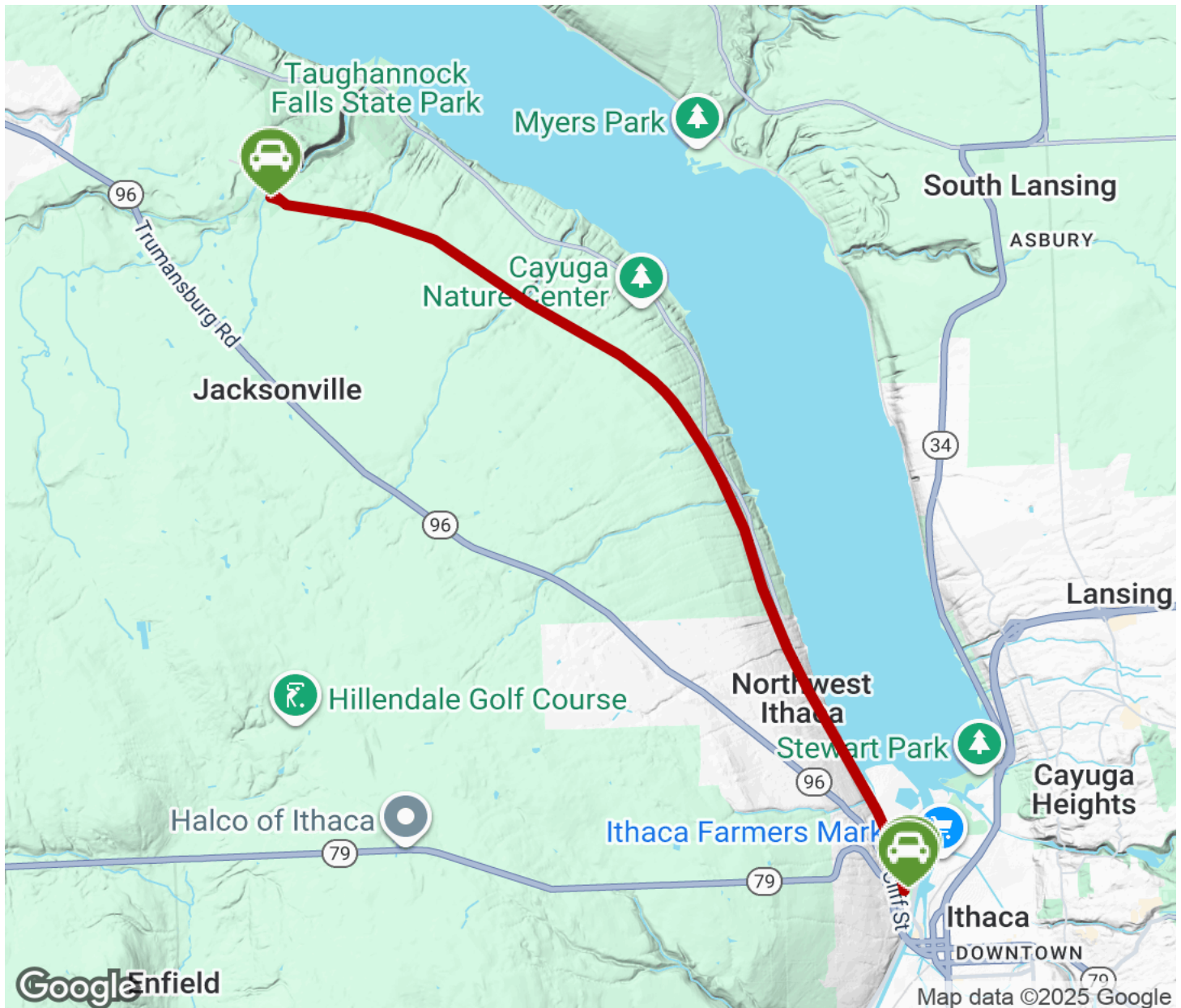
The Black Diamond Trail runs between 121 Turtle Ln. (Ithaca) and Jacksonville Rd. (Ithaca), with parking available on both ends.
