Briar Creek Greenway will one day stretch 6 miles through Charlotte and connect to the Little Sugar Creek Greenway.



Briar Creek Greenway will one day stretch 6 miles through Charlotte and connect to the [Little Sugar Creek Greenway](#). Currently, the trail is open in two disconnected segments totaling 1.4 miles.

The shorter, northern section runs about a half mile between the Merry Oaks and Plaza Midwood neighborhoods. Mid-way, you find a pedestrian bridge over a wooded creek. Further south, another mile of trail flanks the west side of Myers Park High School.

Parking & Trail Access

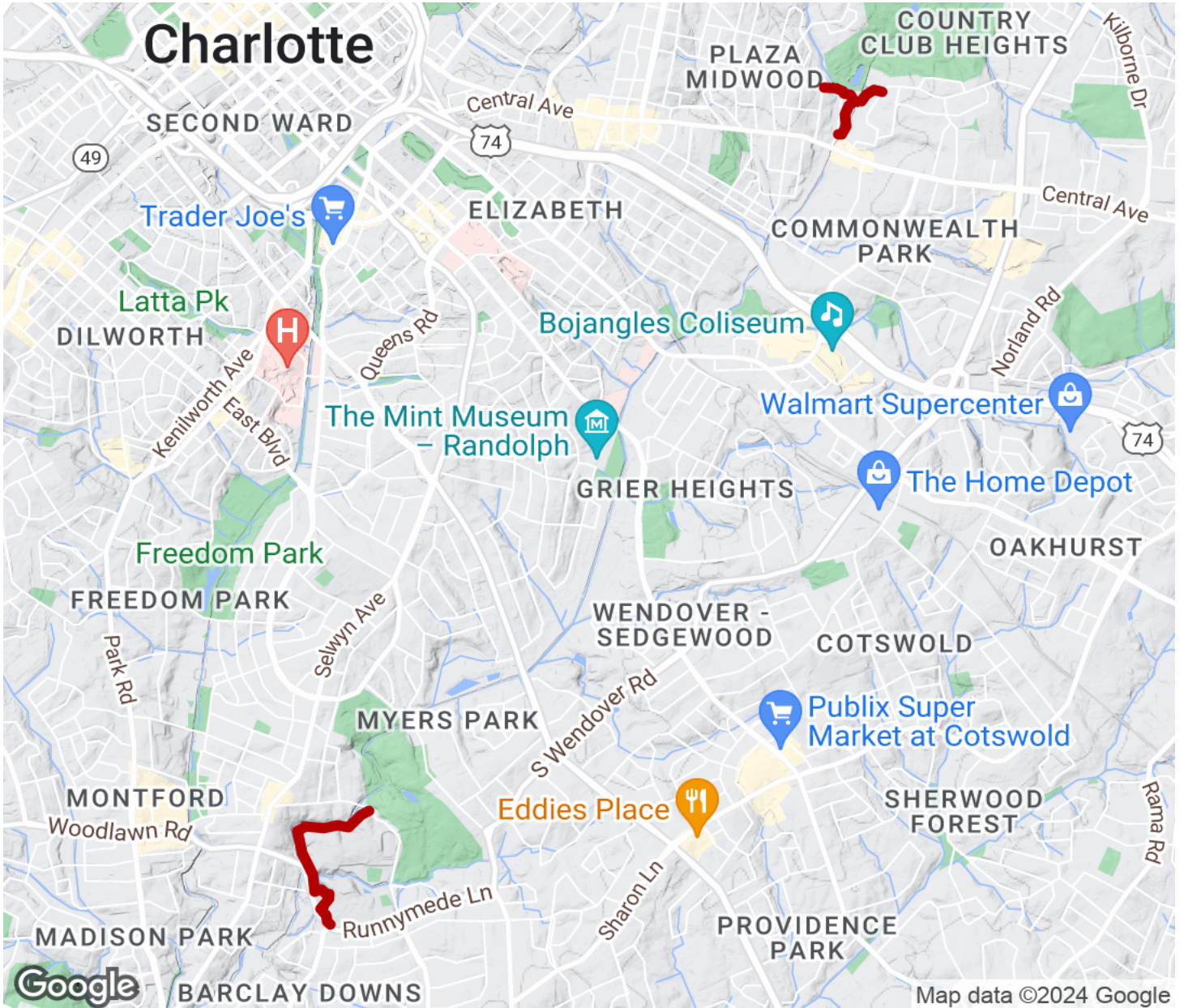
For the northern segment: On-street parking is available on Masonic Drive.
