The trail begins at the West Street entrance to the park. From there, you can also follow the sidewalk south for a block along Island Street to reach the [Cheshire Rail Trail](#). The scenic rail-trail heads west and north toward the Vermont border.

At the north end of the park, the trail also connects to the [Appel Way Trail](#), which heads to Wheelock Park.


Parking & Trail Access
