Rich King Memorial Greenway offers a paved, northsouth route along the east side of Naples. It extends 3 miles through a powerline corridor with residential neighborhoods to either side and canal views on its southern end.

When the project was first being considered, Rails-to-Trails Conservancy assisted with the negotiation of land easements from adjacent landowners, as well as with the trail feasibility study. The trail opened to the public in 2011 and was named after a radio host who had lived in the area for many years and was a valued community member.
