Lafayette Heritage Trail winds through quiet woodlands on Tallahassee's east side, connecting Lafayette Heritage Trail Park and Tom Brown Park. Both parks offer nice amenities including covered picnic tables, restrooms, and drinking water. The trail curves around Piney Z Lake, where there are fishing piers and a boat launch. Along the way, look for turtles, alligators, and many types of birds.

On the trail's eastern end, a pedestrian bridge connects the trail to the J.R. Alford Greenway. On the trail's west end, trail users can connect to the [Goose Pond Trail](#), which traverses Tom Brown Park.

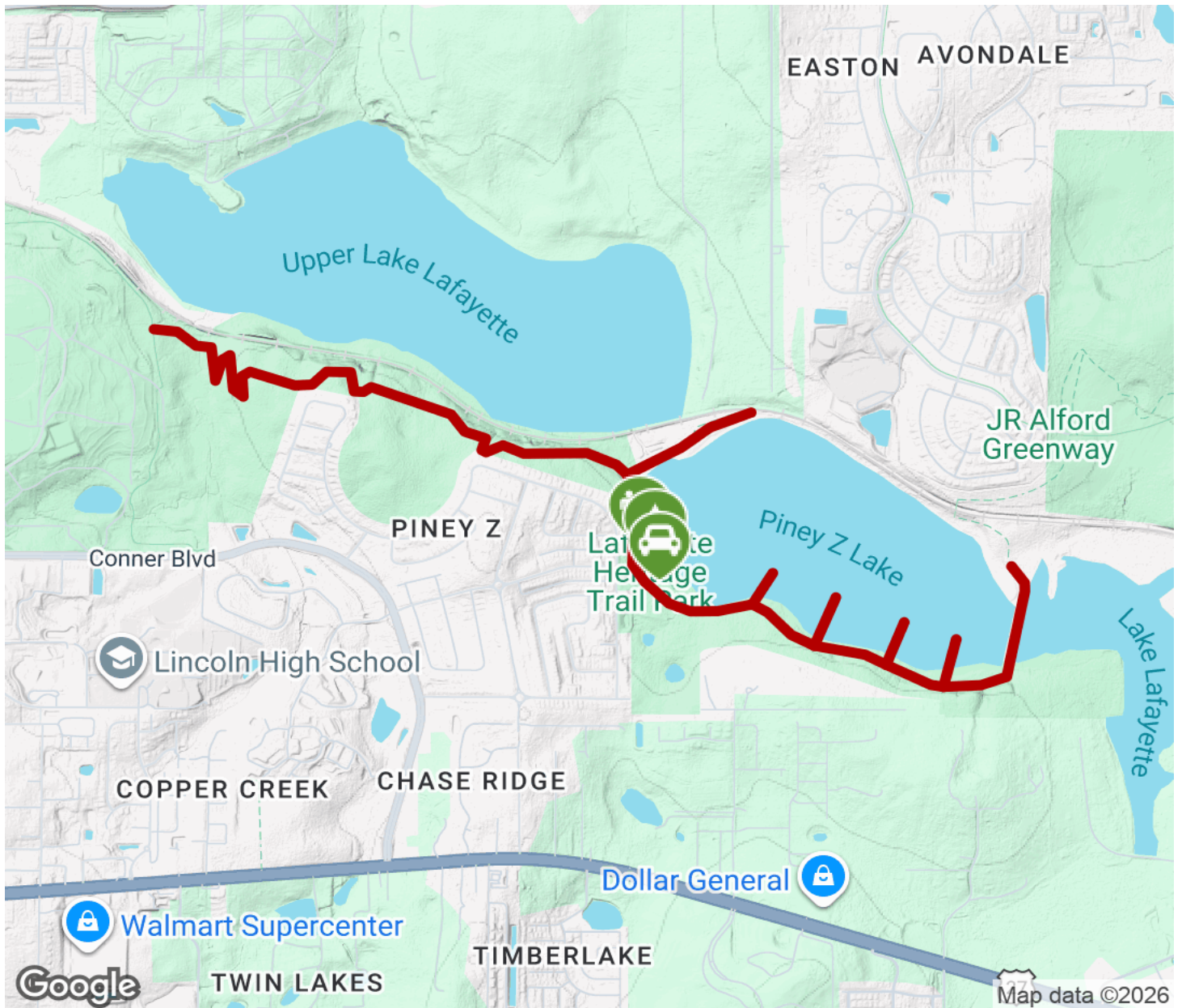
