The western end of the path connects the fringe of the town of Mooresville to a number of subdivisions along Landersdale Road, ending at Heartland Crossing.

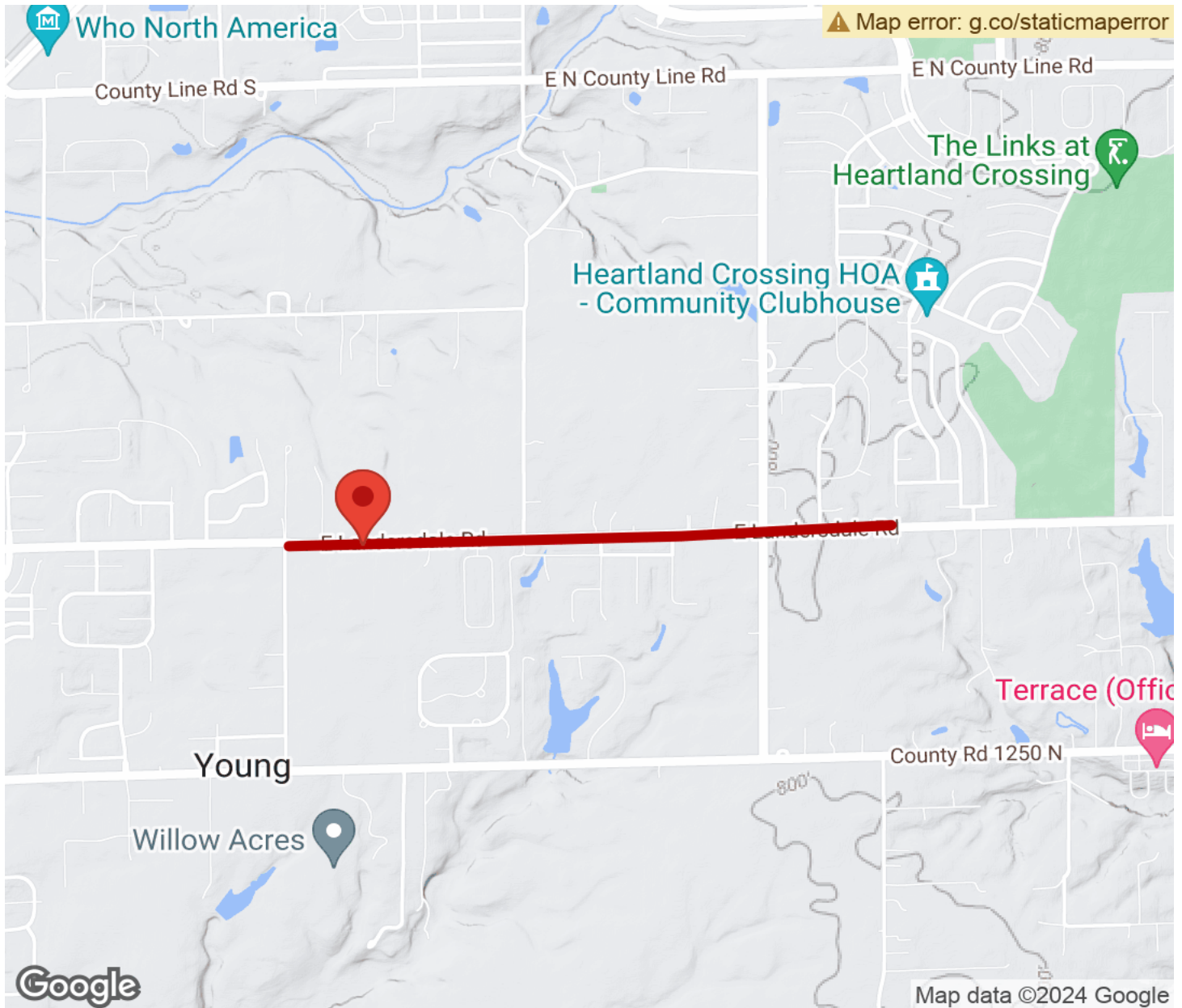
Parking & Trail Access

Take State Highway 67 to the Bridge Street traffic light in Mooresville. Turn east on Bridge Street; travel past the grocery store and proceed one mile to the first stop sign. Go forward on Landersdale Road to the first entrance to the parking lot by the soccer field; the parking lot is the trailhead.
