While currently less than 0.5 mile long, plans are in the works to extend it farther northeast to Business Loop 70. The rail-with-trail parallels the city-owned Columbia Terminal (COLT) Railroad, which provides freight access to Columbia from a Norfolk Southern main line in Centralia.

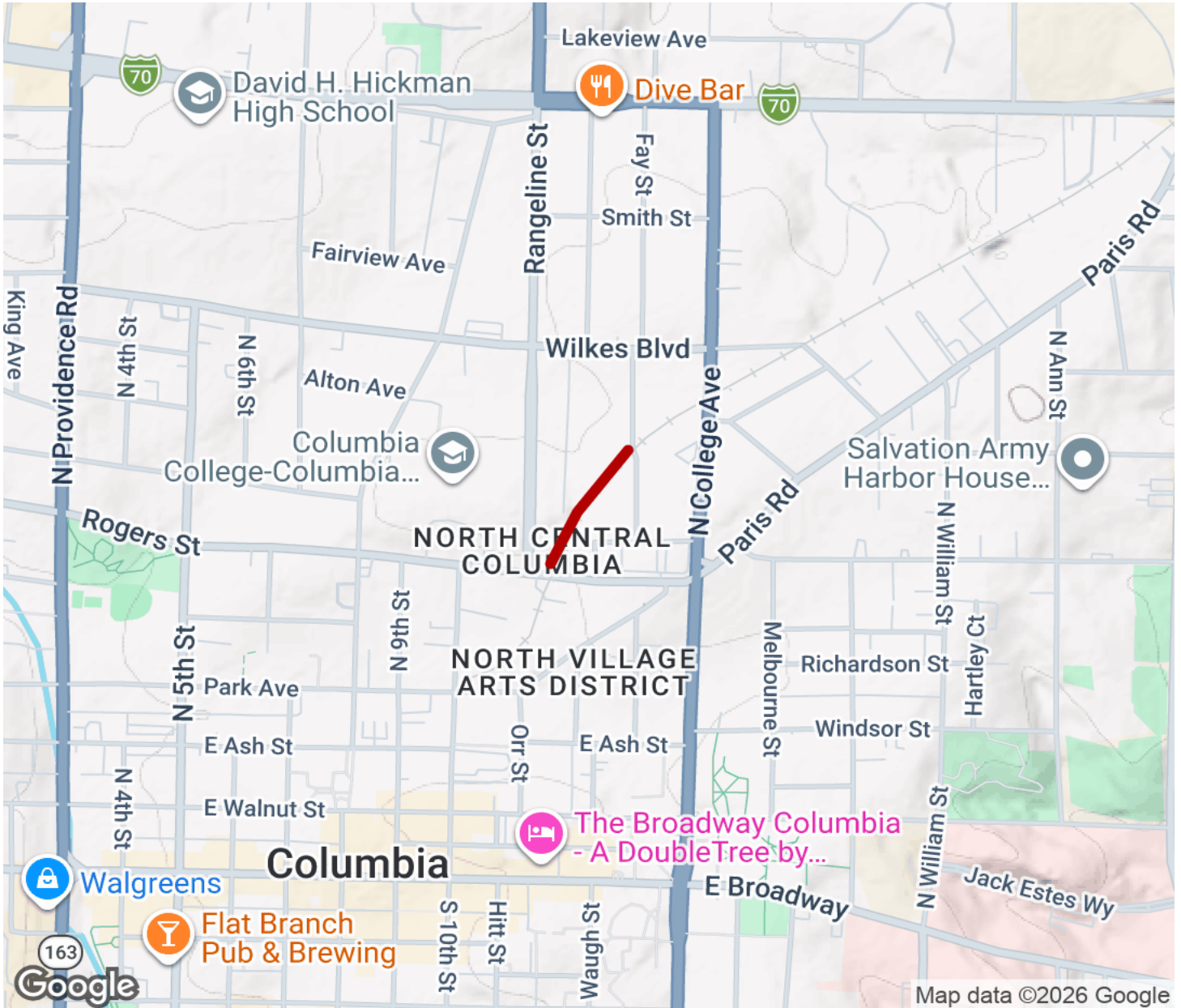
