Indiana's Trolley Line Trail runs through popular Happy Hollow Park in West Lafayette. In addition to the paved trail, the 81-acre park offers a softball field, open turf area, hiking trails, playgrounds and picnic shelters. A sledding hill is often packed with families in the winter.

The trail occupies a portion of the route of the Lafayette Street Railway, which ceased operations in 1940. Lafayette's streetcar system is famous as the first to be fully electrified in Indiana—the railroad's owners having completed the task in 1888. Now, the route's dense woodland surroundings provide a peaceful place for a walk, run or bike ride.

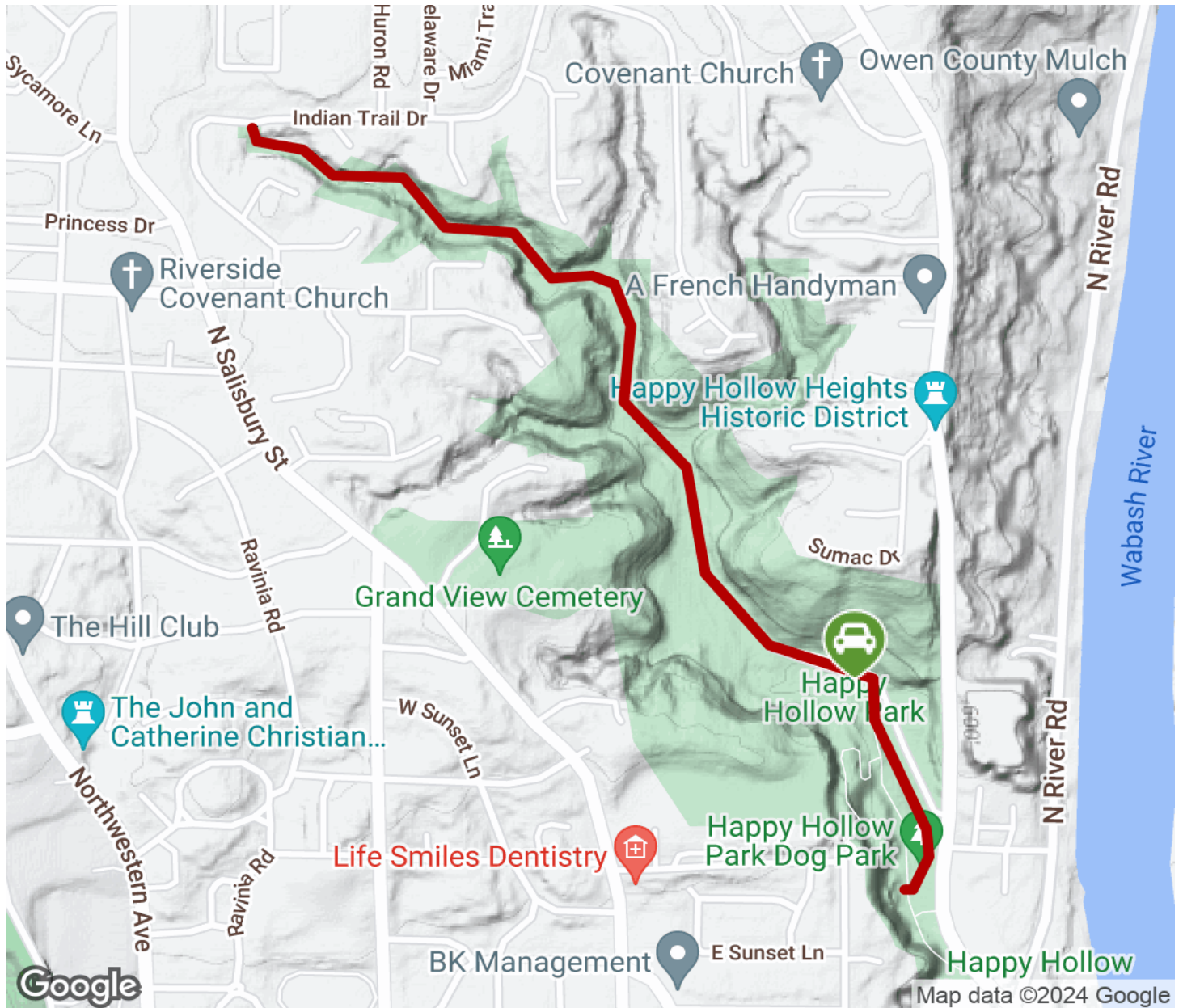
Parking & Trail Access
