This rail-with-trail bridge crosses the Potomac River near its confluence with the Shenandoah River, at Harpers Ferry, West Virginia. A cantilevered section of the bridge allows pedestrian access between Harpers Ferry and the <u>Chesapeake & Ohio Canal National Historic Park</u> (C&O Canal Towpath) and connects the Appalachian Trail from West Virginia to Maryland.
