*The Great Valley Trail, built on the former Lehigh & New England Railroad, offers an unpaved, natural experience through quiet*



The Great Valley Trail, built on the former Lehigh & New England Railroad, offers an unpaved, natural experience through quiet woodlands between the townships of Hampton and Frankford.

Although only 4.3 miles long, the rail-trail connects with two other rail-trails—the [Sussex Branch Trail](#) and the [Paulinskill Valley Trail](#)—for a continuous 13.5-mile loop. The loop uses 4.9 miles of the Paulinskill Valley Trail and 4.3 miles of the Sussex Branch Trail.

Parking is available at Augusta Hill Road, where the Sussex Branch Trail and the Great Valley Trail intersect. Parking is also available at County Route 519.



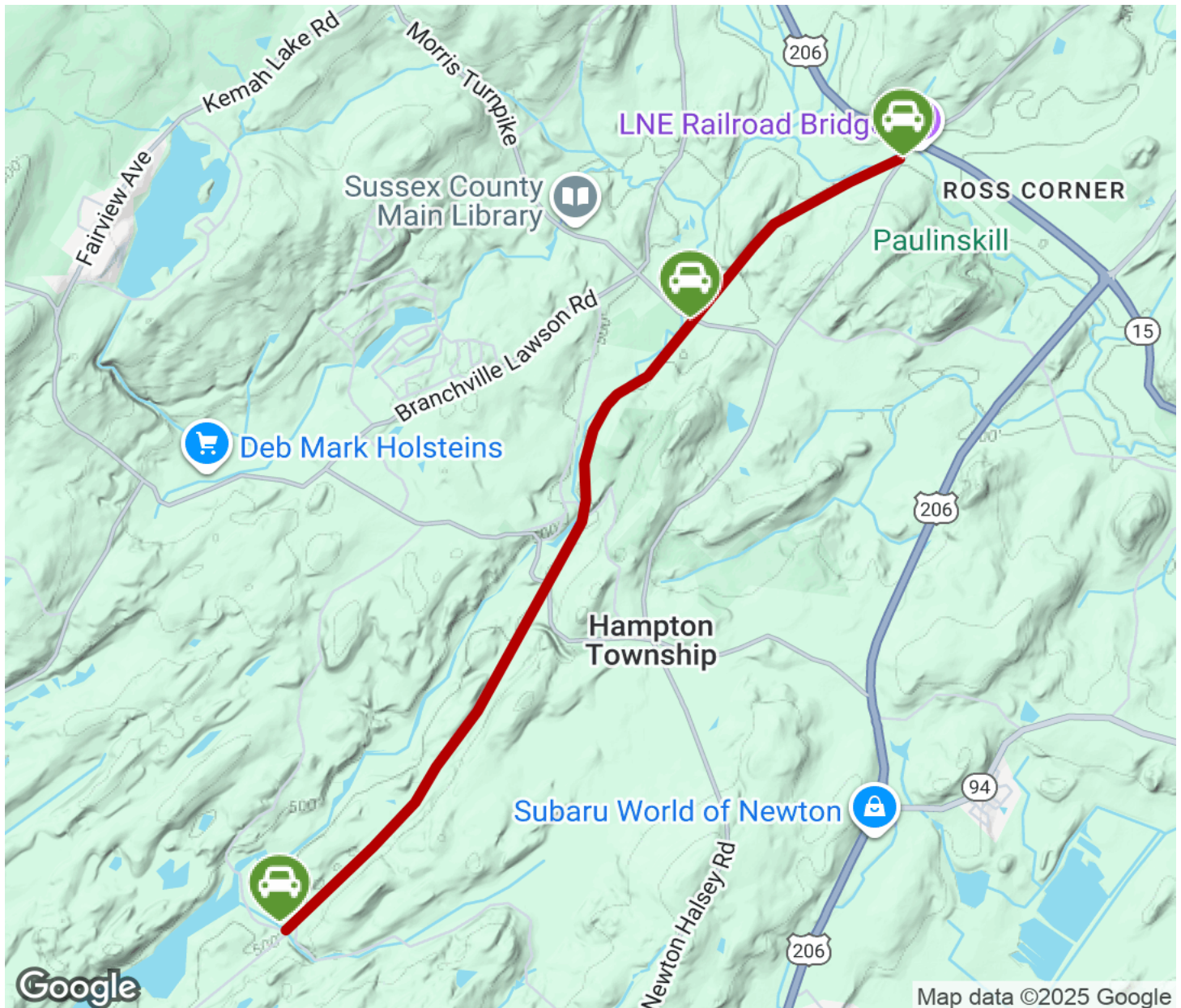
