The Great Valley Trail, built on the former Lehigh & New England Railroad, offers an unpaved, natural experience through quiet



The Great Valley Trail, built on the former Lehigh & New England Railroad, offers an unpaved, natural experience through quiet woodlands between the townships of Hampton and Frankford.

Although only 4.3 miles long, the rail-trail connects with two other rail-trails—the <u>Sussex Branch Trail</u> and the <u>Paulinskill Valley Trail</u>—for a continuous 13.5-mile loop. The loop uses 4.9 miles of the Paulinskill Valley Trail and 4.3 miles of the Sussex Branch Trail.
