

CE Trail Wisconsin



The CE Trail, one of the longest trails in the Fox Valley region of Wisconsin, links Appleton and Kaukauna along busy County



The CE Trail, one of the longest trails in the Fox Valley region of Wisconsin, links Appleton and Kaukauna along busy County Highway CE. While not particularly scenic, the trail offers access to a number of amenities in those two cities (as well as Kimberly and Combined Locks), including Kimberly High School, Kaukauna High School, restaurants, retail and the local YMCA.

The trail is also convenient to residents of the neighborhoods along County Highway CE; three underpasses and a handful of at-grade crossings provide access to those on the south side of the road. In the west, the CE Trail connects directly to the Newberry Trail, which travels northwest to Appleton's riverfront. Near the eastern endpoint in Kaukauna, the Konkapot Creek Trail offers a scenic diversion along the adjacent waterway.
