The Konkapot Creek Trail is a short gravel pathway that follows the winding tributary of the Fox River through Kaukauna. On its south end, the trail connects directly to the <u>CE Trail</u>, which travels east–west from Kaukauna to Appleton.

Near the northern endpoint of the Konkapot Creek Trail, a short connector path leads to Horseshoe Park, which offers a playground, picnic pavilion and baseball diamonds.
