Along the way, you'll travel through a mix of open spaces and woodsy coverage, and pass residential neighborhoods and two golf courses.

A not-to-miss stop is the Lilly Nature Center, where the trail crosses Lindberg Road; there you'll find interesting information on the wildlife of the surrounding Celery Bog Nature Area.


