The Lake Geneva Bike Path runs through the scenic resort city, offering connections to many of the community's amenities. The



The Lake Geneva Bike Path runs through the scenic resort city, offering connections to many of the community's amenities. The trail has five unique, color-coded segments.

The Blue Route is the rail-trail portion of the bike path and also serves as its spine, as it connects to every other route along the way. In the south, the trail begins near Lake Geneva Middle School on N. Bloomfield Road. Coursing northwest with just a couple deviations from the former rail corridor, the route ultimately emerges into downtown Lake Geneva. A short spur through Donian Park offers scenic views of the White River.

Both the Green Route and Yellow Route branch off from the Blue Route near its midpoint. The Yellow Route offers

the more scenic trek through forested wetlands, while the Green Route is a more direct trip along Townline Road to the sprawling Veterans Park.

The north-south Red Route, which parallels State Route 120, is the longest trail segment. The path provides convenient access to residences and businesses on the east side of Lake Geneva. In the north, the trail takes users directly to a large retail complex on N. Edwards Boulevard.

The Brown Route of the Lake Geneva Bike Path is the shortest but also one of the most critical, as it passes directly in front of Lake Geneva Middle School.

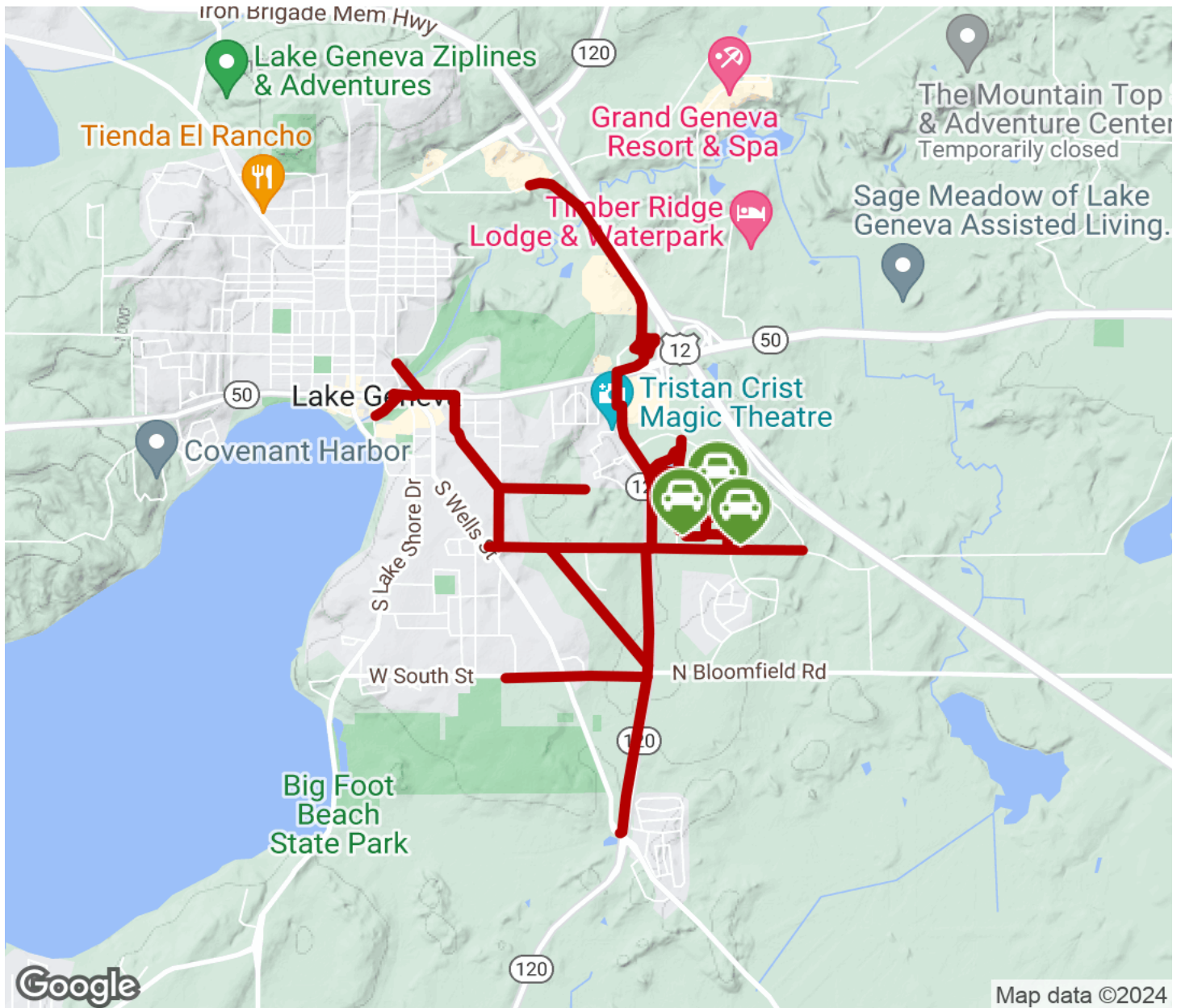
Parking & Trail Access
