Gaston Edwards Trail

Florida

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In northern Orlando, the Gaston Edwards Trail provides a pleasant jaunt of nearly a mile along Lake Ivanhoe's eastern shore. (Hence, the trail is also known as the Lake Ivanhoe Trail.) The paved route is dotted with trees and passes through Gaston Edwards Park; benches, exercise stations, and a playground are available along the way.

For a longer excursion, trail-goers can easily connect to the [Orlando Urban Trail](#), which lies about two blocks south from trail's end on Magnolia Avenue.

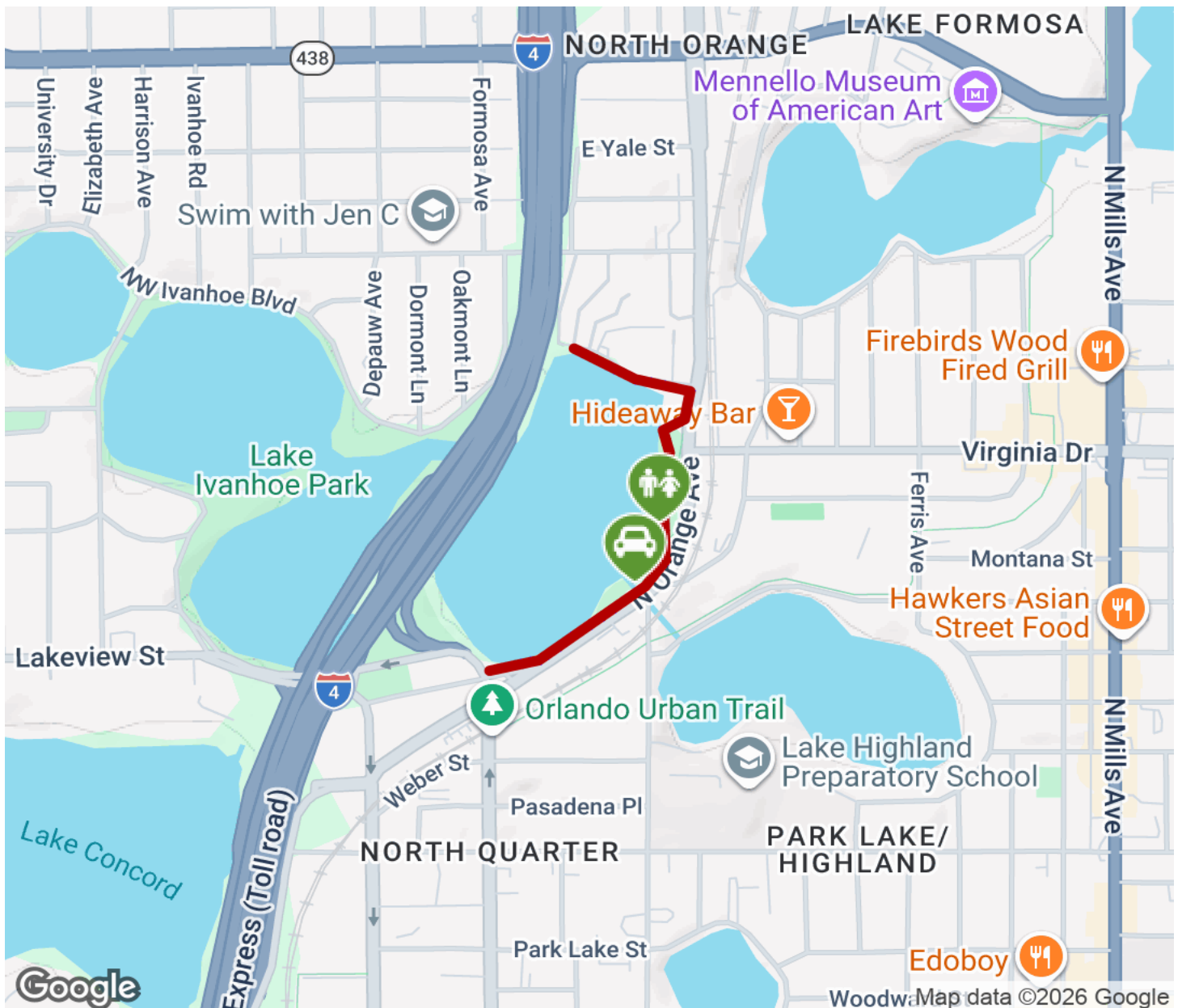
Parking & Trail Access
