On its western end it connects to the [Sammamish River Trail](#) and on its eastern side to the [Redmond Central Connector](#). The eastern section of the trail winds through Bear Creek Park, a lush oasis in the heart of town. The trail is pleasant and tree-lined as it winds along its namesake creek just south of Redmond Town Center, which offers shops, restaurants, and entertainment.

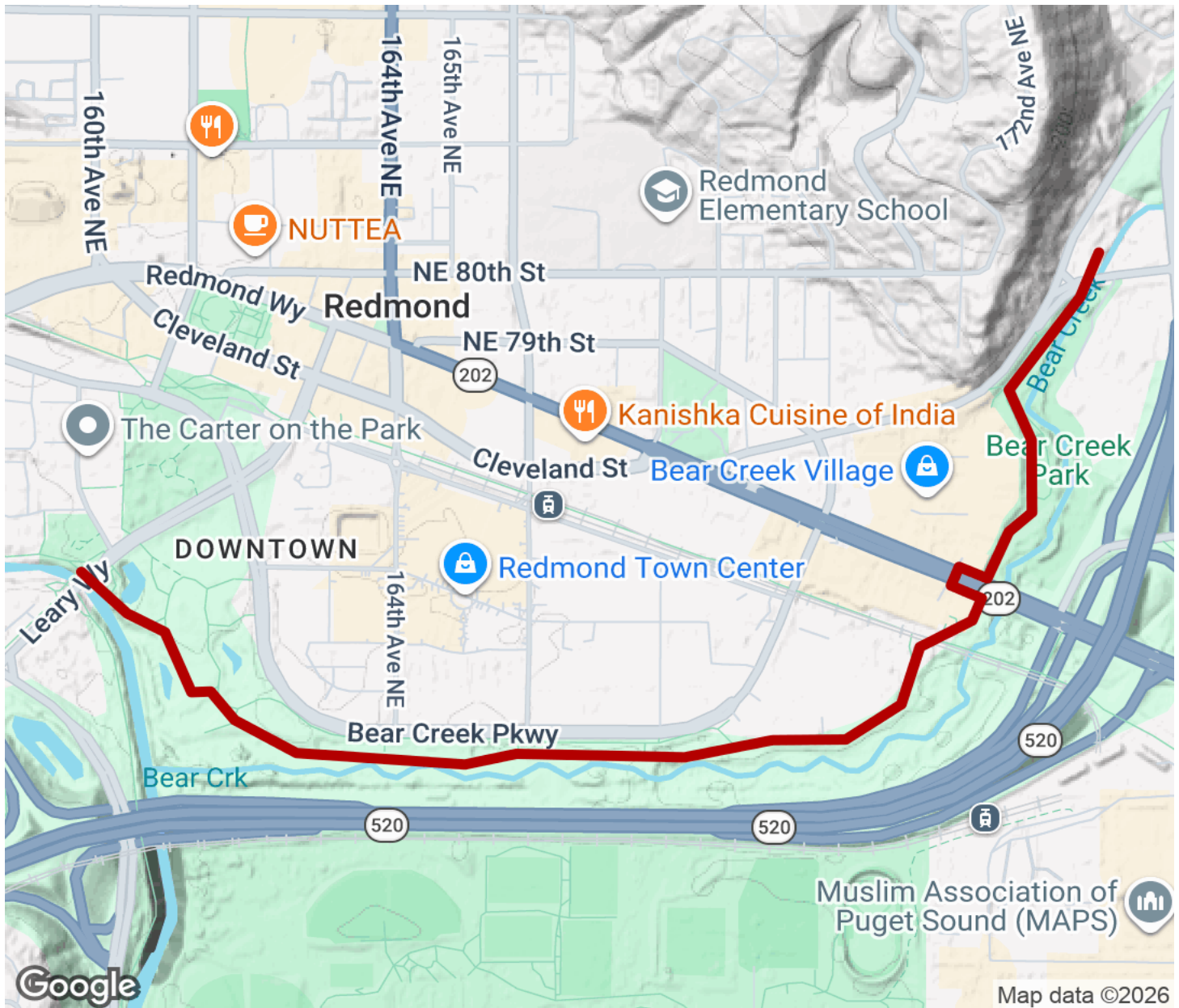
