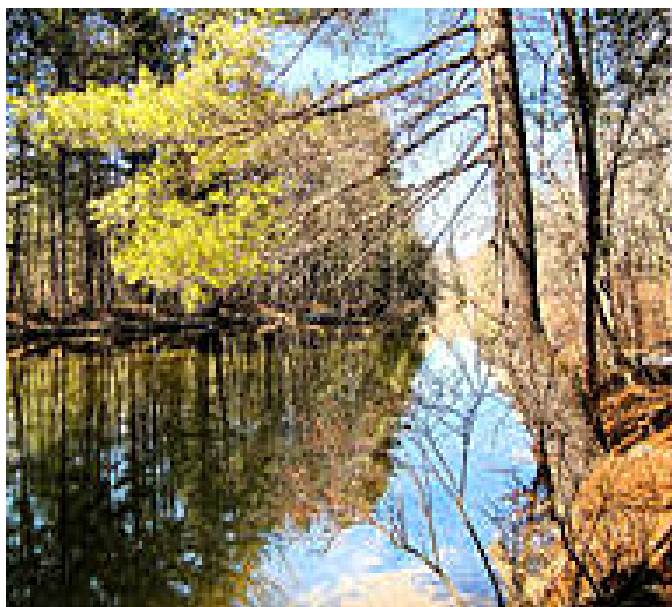

Parking is available on the west end of the trail in Wheelock Park, 101 Park Ave. In the summer, restrooms are also available in the park.



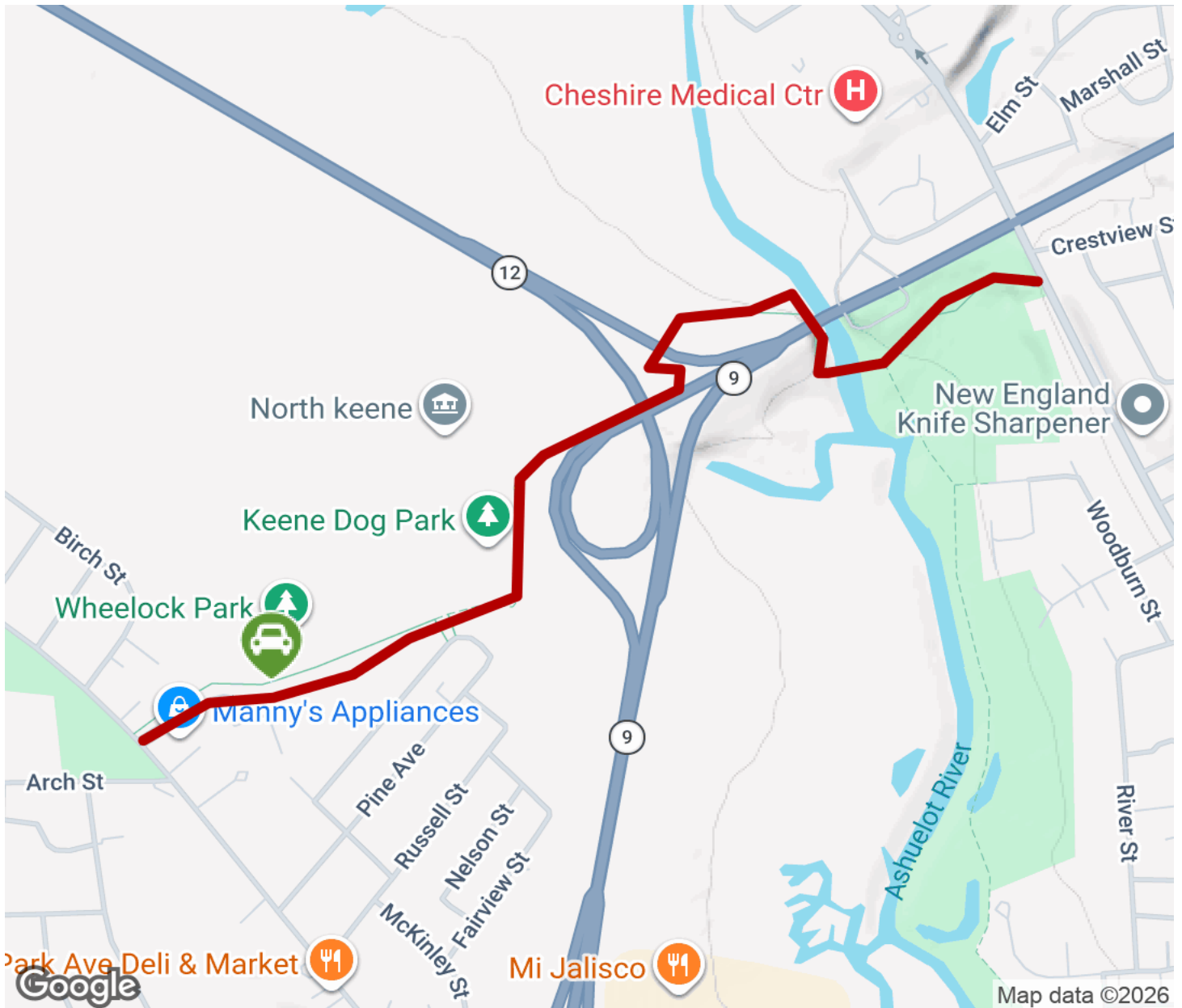
