The Medbery Bike Trail runs from a junction with the Hart-Montague Trail State Park and White Lake Pathway in Montague,

The rail-trail passes primarily through a woodland landscape, but trail users may be able to catch a glimpse of White Lake and the City of Whitehall across the water from the trail's northern end.


